

Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for September 2011 within Chevy Chase Village





Police Activity Requiring A Report -See Zone Map




Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)



By Day of Week




Weekday vs Weekend

September 5, 2011 Burglary

September 23, 2011 Burglary Arrest


