

July 2012 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational Items

1. **Vehicles entered:** 13 thefts from unlocked cars, 1 theft from a locked car (window broken)—purse left in view. The following streets were targeted: West Melrose, East Melrose, East Irving, Nevada, Grafton, Hesketh, Oliver
2. **Recovered stolen car:** Auto stolen in unit block of Hesketh was recovered by DC Police; arrests made; MCPD following up
3. **Fatal collision on July 31:** At 11:42 a.m. on a sunny day, an elderly female passenger died and an adult male driver was critically injured when their car left the roadway to the right and struck a large tree in the 5800 block of Connecticut Avenue.
4. **Targeted theft suppression strategy in progress:** Due to the number of thefts from cars at night, our strategy is twofold:
 - We've analyzed the last 19 months of data (Jan 2011-July 2012) and have directed officers to increase their patrols on the most frequently targeted streets, and
 - We are coordinating with MCPD to use some of their resources in an effort to make some arrests.

Personnel

1. **Training:** Officers Sanchez and Almas attended NCIC (national law enforcement database) recertification at RCPD through a new cooperative agreement
2. **Injury (not work-related):** Officer Timmerman broke his thumb playing sports, and he is assisting with administrative tasks and projects while he heals.

Administrative

1. The hearing on the motion to dismiss in *Richardson v. Fitzgerald et.al.* is scheduled for September 25, 2012 9:30 a.m.
2. CALEA re-accreditation: We have a mock on-site assessment scheduled for October 24.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
