

August 2012 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational Items

1. **Two arrests for theft:** Two young adults from DC were arrested in a joint operation with MCPD for stealing a bicycle from a front porch on Grafton Street near Wisconsin Avenue.
2. **Residential burglary:** An unoccupied home on Grafton Street between Kirkside Drive and Wisconsin Avenue was burglarized from Wednesday, August 8th at 9a.m. to Thursday, August 9th at 1 a.m. Entry was gained by breaking a small window in a rear door. It is unknown at this time if any valuables were removed from the residence.
3. **Thefts from auto:** There were 10 this month; all of them involved unlocked vehicles. We continue to work hard to prevent theft and to arrest those responsible. In the September *Crier*, we urged the residents to do their part by removing valuables from their cars and locking the car doors every time they park.
4. **Burglary trial scheduled:** One of the defendants arrested on March 22 for a burglary on Magnolia Parkway has demanded a jury trial, and it is scheduled for Sept 18 & 19; 4 Village officers will testify.

Personnel

1. **Training:**
 - Four officers attended the first of two days of state-mandated annual **in-service training**.
 - Three officers **qualified with their firearms** for the second time this year (we now require qualifications twice per year; previously, we qualified once to satisfy the state minimum)
 - Sgt. Dasilva and Off. Timmerman attended **e-Tix** (electronic traffic citations) **training**
 - Officer Hrnjak attended *Characteristics of an Armed Gunman* training sponsored by the USDOJ (free) in Baltimore
2. **Injury (not work-related):** As you may recall, Officer Timmerman broke his thumb at the end of July and he has been on light duty since then. He is expected to return to full duty very soon.

Administrative

1. Chief Fitzgerald is scheduled to **travel** twice in September:
 - Maryland Chiefs of Police Annual Seminar, Sunday, 9/9-Wednesday 9/12 (Ocean City)
 - IACP Annual Conference, Friday 9/28-Wednesday, 10/3 (San Diego)
2. On August 21, the Court of Appeals issued its decision in *Baker et. al. v. Montgomery County, et. al.* (speed camera lawsuit brought by Mr. Leahy). **We prevailed.**
3. The hearing on the **motion to dismiss** in *Richardson v. Fitzgerald et.al.* is scheduled for September 25, 2012 9:30 a.m. We recently received a claim notice from attorneys representing the deceased driver's family.



Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for August 2012 within Chevy Chase Village






Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
