

September 2012 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational Items

1. **Second suspect in Magnolia Parkway burglary pleads guilty:** The second of two young adults from DC who were arrested on March 22 has pled guilty to Conspiracy to Commit Burglary; he will be sentenced in November.
2. **Thefts from auto:** There were 4 this month; all of them involved unlocked vehicles. 3 during the daytime occurred on the same day and involved construction vehicles; the suspects were stopped in DC and identified; we anticipate arrests in the near future.

Personnel

1. **Training:**
 - Officer Sanchez attended **Crisis Intervention Training**, a 40-hour tuition-free course co-sponsored by the Montgomery County Police and Department of Health and Human Services; this course teaches verbal and non-verbal communication skills to deal with persons with special needs, with mental illness, and in crisis situations. All officers will attend over the next year or so.
 - Chief Fitzgerald attended the Maryland Chiefs of Police Association annual seminar in Ocean City September 9-12.
2. Officer Timmerman is back to full duty following his injury (broken thumb); we are at full authorized strength.

Administrative

1. Chief Fitzgerald attended the IACP annual conference in San Diego 9/28-10/3
2. The Circuit Court granted our **motion to dismiss** in *Richardson v. Fitzgerald et.al.* on September 25; the Village and Chief Fitzgerald are out of the case.
3. A new law takes effect on January 1, 2013 that will require officers to issue criminal citations in lieu of a physical arrest/statement of charges for petty offenses (misdemeanors punishable by 90 days or less); we are working with the a coalition agencies to draft new policy and train our officers by the end of 2012.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
