

## February 2013 CCVPD Highlights

### Crime/Operational Items

1. **Assault on a Village police officer:** Officer Timmerman made a traffic stop for expired registration plates in the morning hours of Monday, 2/4. The adult female driver blatantly attempted to conceal something inside a bag on the front passenger seat, she remotely opened the trunk, climbed over the center console, darted out the front passenger door, and with Officer Timmerman in pursuit, she threw the bag into the trunk and slammed it shut. She then bit Officer Timmerman on the back of his hand as he tried to restrain her. She was arrested and charged with assault on the officer, possession of marijuana and several traffic charges.
2. **Thefts from auto:** Five car-related thefts occurred. Four cars were entered (2 were unlocked and 2 sustained broken windows); a portion of a front grille was taken from a fifth vehicle.
3. **Weekend door-to-door crime prevention effort is complete:** Officers have finished the prevention campaign. Every home received an informative one-pager with specific theft prevention tips. We hope our residents take heed.

### Personnel/Administrative

1. **Recruitment for Communications vacancy:** Over 160 applications were received; we interviewed 8 of the strongest candidates and we selected Ms. Betty Gabari who will begin training as our newest dispatcher on Monday, March 11.
2. **First aid training:** Sgt. Kevin Parker, paramedic and supervisor of MCPD's Emergency Services Unit, provided training on the treatment of injuries involving life-threatening bleeding
3. **PERF Active Shooter roundtable:** Chief Fitzgerald attended a best practices discussion with 150 chiefs from around the country at the Russell Senate Office Building
4. **Officer overtime to cover dispatch:** 4 hours overtime to cover a partial shift on Friday, February 1 (a dispatcher was in a temporary no-duty status following a dog bite)








## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for February 2013 within Chevy Chase Village




Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
