

January 2013 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational Items

1. **Thefts from auto:** Only 2 unlocked vehicles were entered in January; items were taken from one of them; the other was disturbed, but nothing was taken.
2. **Weekend door-to-door crime prevention visits:** Officers continue to go door-to-door handing out attention-getting prevention literature. The officers report that they have received very positive feedback from our residents.
3. **Security review:** Chief Fitzgerald met with the All Saints Church leadership to review their school safety plan.

Personnel

- **Retirement:** After nearly 9 years of service to the Village, Lead Communications Clerk Doris Lyerly retired on January 11. We immediately started a recruitment process which is now complete. We will be hiring a replacement in the near future.

Administrative

- **Preliminary budget prep:** We worked with the Village Manager and other Department Heads to prepare our proposed FY14 budget (operations and CIP)
- **Public Safety Committee met 1/24:** Committee Chair Saul Goodman convened the PSC to discuss the Police Department's proposed budget-related initiatives. They supported the modest changes proposed by the Chief.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
