

## April 2013 CCVPD Highlights

### Crime/Operational Items

- **Thefts from auto:** Only 1 attempted theft from a car; the owner witnessed a man open his car door, and he yelled at the would-be thief causing him to run off.
- **Protesters that did not come:** We coordinated with Montgomery County Police and others to prepare for a large group of protesters from National People's Action. They bypassed the Village this year.

### Personnel/Administrative

1. **Medication Take Back Day a huge success:** Sgt. Dasilva staffed the drop box, and in a 4-hour period, he took in 191 pounds of unwanted medication. We will work toward obtaining a permanent, secure medication drop box.
2. **Newly-hired dispatcher has completed training:** Ms. Betty Ogwuche has been released and has been going 'solo' on the night shift (6p-6a) since April 27. Communications is now fully staffed.
3. **First of two days of required in-service training completed:** Officers have completed half of their state-mandated annual in-service training.
4. **Facility security plan progresses:** Chief Fitzgerald and Michael Younes met with a security contractor to finalize plans to implement facility security enhancements.
5. **Traffic Safety and Older Drivers:** On April 24, Chief Fitzgerald attended a Maryland Older Driver Safety Symposium sponsored by the MVA
6. **Officer overtime to cover dispatch:** None in April.

### Upcoming

- **National Peace Officers' Memorial Day (May 15) and National Police Week (May 12-18):** In 1962, President Kennedy proclaimed May 15th as National Peace Officers Memorial Day and the calendar week in which May 15th falls, as National Police Week. National Police Week pays special recognition to those law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty for the safety and protection of others.





## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for April 2013 within Chevy Chase Village




Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
