

August 2013 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. **Attempt burglary in 4100 block of Oliver Street:** On Saturday, August 10 at about 12:15, workers witnessed a suspicious van with 2 persons inside. The passenger got out and attempted to pry open a door of a nearby home. The workers called police, and the suspects fled.
2. **Thefts from auto:** In one night (8/25-8/26), 18 unlocked cars were entered on several streets (W. Melrose, W. Kirke, W. Irving, Grafton, Grove, Hesketh, E. Kirke, and E. Melrose), and thieves attempted to steal one car.
3. **Latent fingerprints identify thief:** Officer Sanchez lifted latent prints from a car-related theft in May, and the prints were recently identified as those of a known thief. MCPD detectives are following up.
4. **NNO on Tuesday, August 6 was a hit:** Fun was had by all. Board Chair Pat Baptiste, Assistant Treasurer Bob Goodwin, Board Member Elissa Leonard and many Village residents mingled with Village and county police officers, the Village Manager and staff, members of the B-CC Rescue Squad and county firefighters. Mr. Saul Goodman was the grill master.

Administrative

1. **New employee:** On Monday, August 12, Ms. Heidi Rottman was hired as our newest dispatcher. Her training will be completed this week and she is doing very well.
2. **New Medication Drop Box installed:** We have installed a new, grant-funded steel drop box to provide residents with a convenient and safe way to dispose of unwanted medications. It is located in the hallway to the left of the lobby area in the Village Hall, and the white mailbox-style receptacle is available to residents 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
3. **Official CALEA re-accreditation in Columbus, OH:** We received our official Accreditation with Excellence in early August. Congrats to all those involved.
4. **Police officer overtime to cover dispatch:** 36 hours (3 12-hour shifts) total for August








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
