

## July 2013 CCVPD Highlights

### Crime/Operational

1. **Thefts from auto:** We had only 1 theft from a vehicle in July; this is very good news. We are hopeful that this downward trend continues.
2. **Right-to-life demonstrators:** On July 23, approximately 25 members of a pro-life group displayed large graphic signs along the northbound Connecticut Avenue sidewalk for two hours during the afternoon rush. Village officers were on the scene to ensure clear sight lines for traffic safety, and to keep the peace. This year, several irate motorists stuck in the stop-and-go traffic yelled and gestured angrily at the demonstrators, but there was no violence.
3. **No bicycle thefts in July:** We were fortunate that no bicycles were reported stolen in July, while DC had several such reports. Residents are urged to keep their bicycles secured.
4. **Arrest of bicycle thief:** Officer Sanchez spotted a suspicious individual riding a bicycle on Summerfield Road, and when the officer approached to speak with the young man, the suspect fled. Officer Sanchez was able to stop the juvenile male and recover a bicycle that was stolen from Turner Lane in Martin's Additions.

### Administrative

- **Dispatcher resignation:** Jennifer Harkins, a Communications Clerk since 2002, resigned effective July 19. We advertised the vacancy right away and interviewed several promising candidates. We expect to hire a replacement in the near future.

### Upcoming

- **Grant-funded medication drop box awarded to CCVPD:** Upon our application, we have been awarded a free medication drop box. It will arrive within the next 30 days, and it will serve as a secure container to enable residents to safely and conveniently dispose of unwanted medications.



## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for July 2013 within Chevy Chase Village






Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
