

May 2013 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational Items

1. **Thefts from auto:** Three thefts from unlocked vehicles; all were contractor's vehicles and the incidents occurred during the daytime.
2. **Unusual natural death:** A long-time employee of All Saints Church died outside the church; Village officers coordinated with Montgomery County investigators at the scene; cause of death ruled natural.

Personnel/Administrative

1. **All Hands Meeting held on 5/28:** All 16 Police Department employees met from 6p-9p on 5/28 to review new policies, department priorities, the FY14 budget, and other matters. It was a fast-paced meeting with a full agenda, and it was productive.
2. **Medication drop box update:** We have applied for a grant-funded box to serve as a permanent, safe receptacle for unused medications. We will be coordinating as necessary with the Building Facilities Commission.
3. **Officer overtime to cover dispatch:** None in May. We do not anticipate any such overtime going forward now that we are up to full strength in Communications.

Upcoming

- **National Night Out (Tuesday, August 6, 6p-8p):** We have commitments from the Bethesda-Chevy Chase Rescue Squad, County Police (K9), and the fire department to have apparatus displays and demos at the event. It's coming together nicely.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
