

## December 2013 CCVPD Highlights

### Crime/Operational

1. **Crime down significantly in 2013:** Crime in the Village continues to be low overall. Last year at this time, however, I was decrying a 45% increase in one troublesome category: thefts from unlocked cars at night. In 2011, the Village had 67 thefts, and in 2012, we spiked with a high of 97 thefts—a 45% increase in one year. I am very pleased to report that we had only 60 thefts for all of 2013. That number represents a huge reduction (-38%) from last year's total, and it is 10% lower than 2011.
  
2. **Holiday package theft prevention initiative well-received:** In December, officers moved many recently-delivered packages from front porches to prevent thieves from taking them. Three such thefts were reported prior to starting the initiative, and none were reported after we started. While it is hard to know how many thefts were actually prevented, residents clearly appreciated the officers' efforts.
  
3. **Transition to new phone and recording system complete:** In late December, our dispatchers were trained in the new phone system, and they have done a good job learning how the new system works. The change should be seamless for our residents, but we may inadvertently lose a call or two while we adjust to the new features.

### Administrative/Upcoming

1. **New police cars to be built in late January:** Our two replacement cars are scheduled to be manufactured toward the end of the month, and we hope to have them in service by the end of March.
  
2. **Legal update training for officers:** On January 28 & 29, Chief Fitzgerald, Lt. Dasilva, Sgt. Tiedemann, and Officers Hrnjak and Timmerman will be attending a free, 2-day seminar on recent court decisions dealing with Constitutional law and search and seizure.



## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for December 2013 within Chevy Chase Village






Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
