

## November 2013 CCVPD Highlights

### Crime/Operational

1. **Stolen truck; thief arrested in DC:** On 11/8, a Dodge Ram pickup truck was taken from E. Irving Street between Brookville Road and Western Avenue while the owner attended a nearby church service. In the early morning hours of 11/16, DC police stopped the truck and arrested the driver. Criminal charges in Maryland are forthcoming.
2. **Two thefts:**
  - **Unlocked car entered:** On November 9, an unlocked car parked on the street in the unit block of Primrose Street was entered between 10am and 10pm. \$4 in coins taken.
  - **Package stolen from a front porch:** On 11/23, a package was stolen from the front porch of a home in the 100 block of E. Kirke Street between 2pm and 4pm.
3. **Telephone scam:** ‘Lt. Michael Stevens’ from the ‘Warrant Squad’ called several residents and told them that they failed to pay an automated traffic citation. He advised them to pay the citation by purchasing a prepaid card at a Walmart or CVS. No one fell for this pitch, but scammers are everywhere; residents must beware.
4. **New holiday season theft prevention initiative:** Every year at this time, packages are stolen from front steps by thieves targeting deliveries from services such as UPS and FedEx. This year, when Village officers see packages at the front of a house, they will knock on the door to alert the homeowner of the delivery. If no one is home, they will be moving the packages out of sight. Dispatchers will leave a message for the homeowner to alert them of the location.

### Administrative

1. **Firearm qualifications:** The second of two agency-required (MD requires one per year) firearm qualification sessions is underway for 2013.
2. **In-service training:** Officers have completed their 18 hours of state-mandated in-service training requirements





## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for November 2013 within Chevy Chase Village






Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
