

April 2014 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. **Burglary in the unit block of Grafton:** The residents of a home in the unit block of Grafton Street for the weekend. On Sunday, April 27, shortly before noon, a friend of the homeowner entered the house to drop something off, and she discovered a broken pane of glass in the rear kitchen door. The burglar apparently broke the pane then reached through and unlocked the door using the thumb-turn deadbolt.
2. **Three unlocked cars entered:** Three unlocked cars were entered overnight Tuesday, 4/22- Wednesday, 4/23 in the 100 block of Grafton Street. All three cars had been parked in the homeowners' driveways. Two of the cars were parked at one home, and the third car was parked at the home next door. In each case, the glove compartments and center consoles were left wide open, but nothing was taken from any of the cars.
3. **Second new patrol car in service**

Training/Administrative

1. **Sgt. Tiedemann completed first-line supervisor's school**
2. **Annual in-service training:** All officers have completed the first of 2 days of mandated in-service training
3. **All officers to receive naloxone training by June 18:** We were able to enroll officers in two additional sessions of the Overdose Response Program training course given by the County Department of Health and Human Services. All officers will be carrying naloxone by June 18.
4. **The first of two semi-annual firearms qualifications will occur in May**








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
