

May 2014 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. **Attempted burglary in the 5500 block of Montgomery:** On the morning of May 13, residents of a home in the 5500 block of Montgomery Street discovered fresh pry marks on the French doors at the rear of the house. Between 1:00 a.m. and 7:30 a.m., someone used a pry tool in an unsuccessful effort to break into the home. The door was never opened and the burglar did not gain entry into the home.
2. **One unlocked car entered:** On Friday, May 30, a resident of the 5600 block of Western Avenue discovered that someone had entered his unlocked car during the night. Nothing was **taken, but the car had been rummaged through. The car had been parked behind the house in the alley.**








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
