

## July 2014 CCVPD Highlights

### Crime/Operational

1. **Two thefts—one from an unlocked work truck, the other from a back yard:**
  - **5600 block of Western Avenue:** On July 10, a resident discovered that a hammock valued at \$150 and some plants valued at \$10 were missing from her back yard which abuts an alley. The date and time of the theft is uncertain.
  - **Connecticut at Newlands:** On July 22 at about 1:00 p.m., an iPhone 5 valued at \$500 was stolen from an unlocked construction truck; the construction crew was working on the roadway; a suspect has been identified, and detectives from MCPD are following up
  
2. **Right-to-life demonstrators on July 29:** The activist group Defend Life displayed their large, graphic anti-abortion signs from 4pm-615pm along the northbound Connecticut Avenue sidewalk. The group was peaceful and the demonstration was uneventful.

### Administrative/Training

1. **Ill employee:** Lead Communications Clerk Bruce Gessford suffered a cardiac event the week of July 14; he has been undergoing treatment and he is expected to return to work soon.
  
2. **Police officer overtime to cover Communications:** 4 hours of overtime was required from 6p-10p on 7/21 due to short staffing (Mr. Gessford's illness)
  
3. **Training seminar:** Chief Fitzgerald and Lt. Dasilva attended a 2-day free training seminar sponsored by LGIT. The presenter was a nationally-known police legal advisor, and the topics covered included the selection of good police officers, and managing the discipline function.
  
4. **Discussions with Xerox:** Staff has begun to meet with Xerox representatives to discuss terms for a renewed contract; the current contract term concludes at the end of this calendar year



## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for July 2014 within Chevy Chase Village






Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
