

November 2014 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. **Daytime house break-in (classified as burglary) on 11/05.** Between 1:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m., unknown person(s) kicked in the front door of a home on E. Irving Street between Connecticut Avenue and Brookville Road. Bedrooms were ransacked. A laptop computer was stolen.
2. **No thefts from autos reported.** The only reported theft involved cash stolen from inside a home by someone who had been given access.

Administrative/Training

1. **Sgt. Tiedemann attended training mandated by the new speed camera law.** As Program Administrator, Sgt. Tiedemann was required to attend a new 1-day course presented by the State of Maryland to satisfy one of the many requirements of the modified speed camera statute.
2. **Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Training continues:** Officer Almas attended this tuition-free 40-hour course sponsored by the County Police which teaches officers to better communicate with and de-escalate situations involving persons with disabilities, mentally or developmentally disabled individuals, and persons in emotional crises. The remaining sworn staff will complete this course in 2015.
3. **Lt. Dasilva attended Technology for Law Enforcement Conference:** This 1-day, no cost seminar reviewed current technologies in use or available to Maryland law enforcement agencies, and the legal requirements involved in using them.
4. **Chief Fitzgerald continues work with Governor's Office body camera workgroup:** The report to the legislature is now being finalized.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
