

December 2014 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. No thefts/attempt thefts from autos reported for the second consecutive month.
2. Thefts are down 37% over last year and 61% as compared to our peak in 2012. We are grateful to the residents who have chosen to 'light it up and lock it up,' and we hope that this trend continues through 2015.

Administrative/Training

1. **Sgt. Tiedemann attended two seminars.** On 12/10 & 12/11, Sgt. Tiedemann attended a tuition-free 2-day seminar on officer safety sponsored by the Maryland Police Training Commission. On 12/16, he attended a short course at the Montgomery County Police Academy on synthetic and non-traditional controlled substances.
2. **Patrol officers attended seminars:** Officer Hrnjak attended a defensive driving course presented by LGIT (our municipal insurer); Officer Timmerman attended a seminar at the Montgomery County Police Academy on drug investigations for patrol officers.
3. **Work ends on GOCCP body camera committee:** Chief Fitzgerald completed his commitment to the Governor's Office workgroup and the white paper was published and sent to the legislation. Bills are expected in the upcoming session.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
