

February 2015 CCVPD Highlights

I. Crime/Operational

1. **Bait car nets two arrests:** In the early morning hours of Thursday, February 12, Communications Clerk Tim Wainscott watched a live streaming video of an unknown man entering the bait car on Primrose Street. Village and County officers responded, and two men in their 30's (one from DC, the other from Prince George's County) were arrested and charged with entering several unlocked cars on Primrose.
2. **Graffiti case closed:** Information from multiple confidential sources led to the identification of juveniles responsible for the recent graffiti incidents in the Village. There is no gang connection to the vandalism. The persons admitted to the acts, and we expect that the problem has now ended.

II. Administrative/Upcoming

1. **Body Camera Bill (SB482/HB627):** We have learned that the Maryland ACLU drafted the language sponsored by Senator Ramirez. The Maryland ACLU's senior counsel has agreed to work with Chief Fitzgerald to draft some amendments to make the bill better while Ms. Baptiste and the Chief collaborate to meet with the co-sponsors from our district.
2. **New patrol schedule started on Saturday, March 7:** A more efficient schedule that combines 10-hour and 12-hour work days for patrol officers has begun. The schedule will significantly decrease the number of shifts where officers work alone. We hope the officers acclimate quickly to the change.
3. **Sworn staff to be 100% CIT certified in mid-March:** As a result of a 2+ year-long effort, as of March 19, all Village officers will have completed the 40-hour Crisis Intervention Training course through the Montgomery County PD. The course trains officers to defuse volatile situations without using force, prepares them to better communicate with persons with special needs, and to manage individuals in crisis through the use of verbal and non-verbal techniques.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
