

# January 2015 CCVPD Highlights

## I. Crime/Operational

- **Four unlocked cars entered:** In the early morning hours of Friday, January 9, the police received a call for a suspicious man pulling on car door handles in the area of Primrose Street and Connecticut Avenue. Two Village police officers responded and arrived in two minutes. The man was not located. Four unlocked cars were entered; nothing was taken from three of them, and \$5 was taken from one.

## II. Administrative/Upcoming

1. **FY 2016 budget prep:** Members of the Police Department have been working with the Village Manager to prepare a proposed budget for FY16 for review by the Board.
2. **Maryland Chiefs' Legislative Committee:** Chief Fitzgerald is attending weekly meetings where the impact of pending bills is discussed. He will keep the Village Manager and the Board informed of bills that may affect the Village.
3. **New patrol schedule to be implemented in March:** A more efficient schedule that combines 10-hour and 12-hour work days will begin on March 7, 2015. The schedule will significantly decrease the number of shifts where officers work alone. The result will be increased public safety services, increased officer safety, and improved leave management.
4. **Portable fingerprint readers will be operational soon:** We have received 3 grant-funded, portable fingerprint readers that will allow officers to identify persons. These devices will enable an officer to identify wanted persons, and, more importantly, to avoid the mistake of arresting an innocent person whose name and birth date match those of a wanted subject.



## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for January 2015 within Chevy Chase Village






Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
