

March 2015 CCVPD Highlights

I. Crime/Operational

1. **There were no reported thefts or burglaries in March.**
2. **Mobile fingerprint readers implemented:** We have finally received our 3 mobile automated fingerprint readers (one per cruiser), and all officers have been trained to use them. This technology will help officers to identify unknown persons (suspects, persons with dementia, etc.) with greater certainty which will help them to arrest persons who are wanted but who provide us with false information, and to avoid arresting the wrong persons.

II. Legislative update:

1. **Body-Worn Camera (BWC) Bills (SB482/HB627):** These bills created a framework for the use of BWCs and for the dissemination of BWC recordings under the Public Information Act. They did not make it out of their respective committees in spite of the fact that the Chiefs/Sheriffs and the ACLU combined forces to support significant amendments to the bills.
2. **Full immunity for administering Naloxone is likely (SB516/HB745):** These bills are on track to pass both houses of the state legislature.
3. **The Board may be required to approve the 'local designee' (aka ombudsman) for SafeSpeed (SB132/HB1086):** The Senate bill passed 46-0 in the Senate and is now in the House; the identical House bill received an unfavorable report from the Environment and Transportation Committee and was withdrawn. We are watching this, and if it passes, Board action will be required to approve the selection of the local designee.
4. **Quarterly audits of SafeSpeed will not be required (HB271):** This bill was sponsored by 23 delegates, but it received an unfavorable report from the Environment and Transportation Committee. There was no Senate crossfile, so this bill is (thankfully) dead.

III. Administrative/Upcoming

1. **New dispatcher-in-training:** One of our midnight dispatchers, Tim Wainscott, has tendered his resignation effective April 29. We have hired his replacement, **Ms. Mary Gilligan**, who has begun her 4-week training period. We will miss Tim, and we are pleased with our good fortune in finding Mary.
2. **Sworn staff is now 100% CIT certified:** All sworn officers, including Chief Fitzgerald, have completed a 40-hour Crisis Intervention Training course jointly taught by MCPD and the County's Health and Human Services Department. There is a great deal of attention on such training nationally, and since our effort began a couple of years ago, we are fully trained.



Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for March 2015 within Chevy Chase Village






Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
