

# August 2015 CCVPD Highlights

## I. Crime/Operational

### 1. 5 unlocked cars entered:

- Overnight August 17/18: 3900 block of Oliver—\$1 taken; 5500 block of Center—GPS valued at \$200 taken; Summerfield Road—nothing taken.
- Overnight August 24/25: Unit block of Newlands—2 pair of prescription sunglasses taken, total value \$1,800; 6300 Broadbranch—\$2 in change taken.

### 2. 2 unsecured bicycles stolen:

- **Grafton between Kirkside and Wisconsin:** On August 9, a black Fuji road bicycle valued at \$1,000 was taken from the front yard of the resident's home.
- **4000 block of Oliver Street:** Between August 15-18, a black Trek bicycle valued at \$400 was taken from the porch of the resident's home.

## II. Administrative

- **Training completed for Officers Perper and Fones:** Our recently-hired officers have been trained by veteran officers Hrnjak and Timmerman, and Officer Perper and Officer Fones were released to work in a solo capacity as of September 4.
- **Commission on Implementation and Use of Body Cameras:** Chief Fitzgerald completed his work as a member of that commission on September 1. The resulting recommendations will be sent to the Maryland legislature and the Police Training Commission by October 1; the Training Commission will issue regulations no later than January 1, 2016.
- **Maryland Chiefs of Police Association annual seminar:** Chief Fitzgerald will be attending this conference in Ocean City September 15-16.



## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for August 2015 within Chevy Chase Village






**Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)**



**By Day of Week**




**Weekday vs Weekend**
