

July 2015 CCVPD Highlights

I. Crime/Operational

1. **15 unlocked cars entered** (most occurred in 2 nights): Several unlocked cars were entered overnight on various Village streets. Ten of the cars were entered on July 1 or July 11. Nothing was taken from about half of the cars; cash and personal items (GPS, sunglasses, etc.) were taken from the others. Montgomery County neighborhoods have had a similar spike near the DC line. Village and County police command staff shared information and focused additional resources in the area.
2. **Two cars with keys inside stolen from same driveway** (both later recovered in DC): On the night of July 11, thieves found keys to 2 cars inside an unlocked car in the unit block of Grafton Street. They stole both cars. Within 3 weeks, both cars were discovered parked and unoccupied in the area of 4th Street NW in Washington, DC. The cars were stolen on the same night that several unlocked cars were entered in the Village; the auto thieves may have been the same petty thieves that entered the other cars, but when they stumbled onto the keyring, they took the opportunity to take the cars.

II. Administrative/Upcoming

- **Two new police officers hired:** We hired Eli Perper and Drew Fones to fill our two vacant police officer positions. Their first day will be Monday, August 10, 2015. The officers will be riding with a veteran officer and will be trained on our policies and procedures for approximately one month before they are released to patrol on their own.



Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for July 2015 within Chevy Chase Village






Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
