

May 2015 CCVPD Highlights

I. Crime/Operational

1. Three bicycles stolen from open garages:

- **5400 block of Grove Street:** On Sunday, May 3, two expensive (\$5,000 each) bicycles were taken from an open garage by 3 suspects who were captured on video while the resident was at home. One, a juvenile, has been identified and admitted to this offense and to another similar event in Friendship Heights.
- **5400 block of Center Street:** On Sunday, May 24, a bicycle was stolen from an open garage while the resident was at home. The residents did not witness the theft.

2. Three thefts from cars:

- **5400 block of Center Street:** On Thursday, May 21, a wallet was discovered by a passer-by on the buffer at Montgomery Street. Identification inside the wallet enabled police to return it to the victim/owner who lives in the 5400 block of Center Street. Investigation revealed that the wallet was removed overnight from the victim's unlocked car.
- **Belmont Avenue at Park Street:** On Saturday, May 23, two suspects broke a car window and stole a laptop computer that was visible from outside the car. The suspects were captured on the Buffer cameras. We are working with DC police to identify the pair.
- **5600 block of Belmont Avenue:** On Monday, May 25, Saks security watched two subjects suspiciously looking into cars in their lot. Security then saw the pair jump the wall onto Belmont Avenue and enter a car parked there. Nothing was stolen. We are working to identify the suspects; the investigation is continuing.

II. Administrative/Training

1. **Recruiting:** We are narrowing the applicant field and will soon select a replacement for our current vacancy. We had a very strong group of applicants and we are optimistic that we will be able to hire a highly qualified individual. We expect to use this same applicant pool for the additional position that will be funded as of July 1, 2015.
2. **In-Service Training:** Officers and dispatchers are in the process of attending annual in-service training at the Montgomery County Police Academy. Police officers are required to attend 18 hours per year; non-sworn employees are attending a 4-hour block that is non-mandatory.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
