

## September 2015 CCVPD Highlights

### I. Crime/Operational

#### Unlocked cars continue to be entered:

- More than 15 cars were entered in September—11 of them in one night. This trend is not unique to the Village, but this is a significant number for us.
- We are working with the county police to reduce this problem, and we have analyzed our data to focus our officers most effectively.

### II. Administrative/Upcoming

- **First annual speed camera report to legislature due soon:** Sgt. Tiedemann and Chief Fitzgerald have been working to collect the required data per the amended statute. We will submit ahead of the October 31 deadline.
- **All Hands Meeting held on 9/21:** All 17 members of the Police Department met on 9/21 and discussed crime trends, policing in the post-Ferguson era, use of force policy, new laws, recently-issued polices and other things. Very productive gathering.
- **IACP Conference October 24-27:** Chief Fitzgerald will be attending this annual conference in Chicago later this month.



## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for September 2015 within Chevy Chase Village






**Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)**
