

Second of Two Stolen Cars Recovered in DC

Car was unoccupied when it was discovered

On Saturday night, July 11, 2015, two cars were stolen from the same driveway in the unit block of Grafton Street; a key ring containing both car keys had inadvertently been left in one of the cars. One of the cars was a grey Audi A3, and the other was a white VW Golf.

On Tuesday, July 28, 2015 at about 6:00 p.m., a citizen called the Metropolitan Police (DC) to report seeing a car with a flat tire and displaying no tags parked and unoccupied at the intersection of Richardson Place and 4th Street in Washington, DC. The officer determined that the car was the VW Golf that had been stolen from a Village resident on July 11.

The car was towed to a police facility in the District of Columbia. The investigation is continuing.
