National Prescription Drug Take Back Day is April 27
Dispose of Unused Medication Properly and Easily at the Village Hall

Unused prescription drugs are a source of two significant and preventable problems: environmental pollution when they are discarded improperly and substance abuse when they fall into the wrong hands. So how should you dispose of unused medication? This year, your Village Police Department is participating in a national medication take-back day on Saturday, April 27 from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. The event is sponsored by the federal government, and law enforcement agencies throughout the nation are participating. Simply bring your unused medication (no liquids, please!) to the Village Hall and drop it in the box that will be attended by a police officer. The Police Department will dispose of the medication properly.
