

July 2016 CCVPD Highlights

I. Crime/Operational

1. **Nine unlocked cars were entered in July** on Hesketh, W. Kirke, W. Lenox, W. Irving (2), Magnolia, Oliver and Grove (2).
 - 4 of the incidents occurred in the daytime between 10:00 am and 12:30 pm; Village and DC police worked together on August 1 to arrest a juvenile believed to be responsible for these daytime events.
 - 5 of the incidents occurred overnight
2. **Daytime package theft in the 5600 block of Grove Street:** A slender black male with shoulder-length dreadlocks riding a motor scooter was sighted in the area of this event and is believed to be responsible. Village, County and DC police are working to locate and identify him.
3. **Pro-Life demonstrators on July 26:** The group Defend Life displayed their graphic signs along northbound Connecticut Avenue from 4-630pm. With the exception of some angry motorists who expressed their displeasure with the signs, the demonstration was uneventful.

II. Administrative

- **Pilot project for ‘Do Not Enter’ enforcement:** On July 25, Village officials including Board Members Mr. Crockett and Mr. Ruda met with Xerox representatives to evaluate a proposed technological solution to reduce the illegal exiting at the intersections of Grafton/Wisconsin and Oliver/Wisconsin.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
