191 pounds of Unwanted Medication was Dropped Off in a 4-Hour Period

This year, your Village Police Department participated in a National Medication Take Back Day on Saturday, April 27 from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Sgt. Dasilva monitored the drop box, and in that four hour period, he received 191 pounds of unused medication filling eight large plastic trash bags. Sgt. Dasilva took the medication to Baltimore for proper disposal on Monday, April 29. Based on the turnout, the Village Police Department is exploring the feasibility of establishing a permanent medication drop box at the Village Hall.
