2 unlocked contractorâ€™s vehicles entered during the day on Wednesday, May 29

5900 block of Connecticut Avenue: A laptop was taken from the seat of a contractorâ€™s unlocked pickup truck parked on the street

Natural Death on Grafton Street
Unusual circumstance triggers initial investigation

On Thursday, May 30, Fire/Rescue units and officers from the Chevy Chase Village Police Department responded to a report of a traumatic injury outside All Saints Church. First responders found a semi-conscious adult male bleeding profusely from an apparent leg injury. The man, a longtime employee of All Saints Church, was transported to a local hospital where he died. Village officers conducted a preliminary investigation, and the cause of the decedentâ€™s injury was unknown, and there were no eyewitnesses to the causal event. In accord with protocol, Village officers notified Montgomery County Police investigators to conduct the follow-up investigation.

It was ultimately determined that the man was not the victim of either an accident or a crime, and that he died of natural causes.
