**Secure Your Bicycles!**  
**3 bikes stolen in the last 2 weeks**

**Bicycle theft trend:** We previously reported a bicycle stolen from an unlocked garage on W. Melrose on June 11, followed by a second bicycle being stolen from an **open garage** on Oxford Street. This week, a third bicycle was taken from the **front porch** of a home on W. Irving Street between Connecticut Avenue and Magnolia Parkway. All of these thefts involved unsecured bikes, and two of them occurred during daylight hours. **Please secure your bicycles”even during the day.** And to aid in identifying your bicycle, stop in at the Village Hall and the police will register your bike, record its serial number, and issue you a free registration decal.

**Neighborhoods Near the Village are Experiencing Thefts and Burglaries**

In the last 2 months, upper northwest DC has had 15 home break-ins and numerous thefts from auto. Last week, the Town of Somerset experienced approximately 20 vehicle-related thefts in one night. Most of the crimes involved unlocked homes and cars. Village police officers are fully aware of the trends in the surrounding areas, and they work hard to prevent crime in the Village”but we need your help. Please **lock your home”s doors and windows”**even during the day, lock your car and remove valuables from view every time you park, and **call the Village Police Department (301-654-7300) whenever you see or hear anything suspicious.**
