On Tuesday, July 23, 2013, a right-to-life group, Defend Life, will be exercising their 1st Amendment rights by displaying large, graphic signs on the sidewalk along northbound Connecticut Avenue from 4pm-6pm. Chief Fitzgerald and several Village officers will be on scene keeping the peace and ensuring traffic and pedestrian safety.

The images on the signs can be upsetting to some, and young children may not understand them. If you typically use northbound Connecticut Avenue in your travels, you may want to consider an alternative route on July 23 between 4pm and 6pm.
