

December 2022 CCVPD Highlights

Operational

- **Car windows broken in two separate events; nothing stolen:**
 - On December 2 at about 10:00 a.m. (according to security video), a thief broke the rear passenger window of a car parked in the 100 block of E. Melrose; the thief did not take anything from the tote bag that had been left on the back seat.
 - On the morning of December 31, Officer Timmerman was doing a house check in the unit block of Newlands Street when he noticed that one of the cars parked in the driveway had a smashed window. A second car in the driveway had also been entered, but the windows of the second car were intact. Nothing was taken from either car.
- **Angry customer throws pen, paper at post office employee:** On December 14, a customer lost his temper at the post office counter and threw a pen and paper at the clerk striking her in the arm; the customer stormed out. The employee wasn't injured, but she reported the assault to the police. The employee said that she would accept an apology from the customer (a Village resident) rather than pressing charges, and the police are working to arrange a conversation between the two.

Administrative

- **Communications staffing:** Our newest employee, Ms. Kelly Baber, successfully completed training and as of December 30, she began working solo on the day shift. We are now at full staffing in Communications.

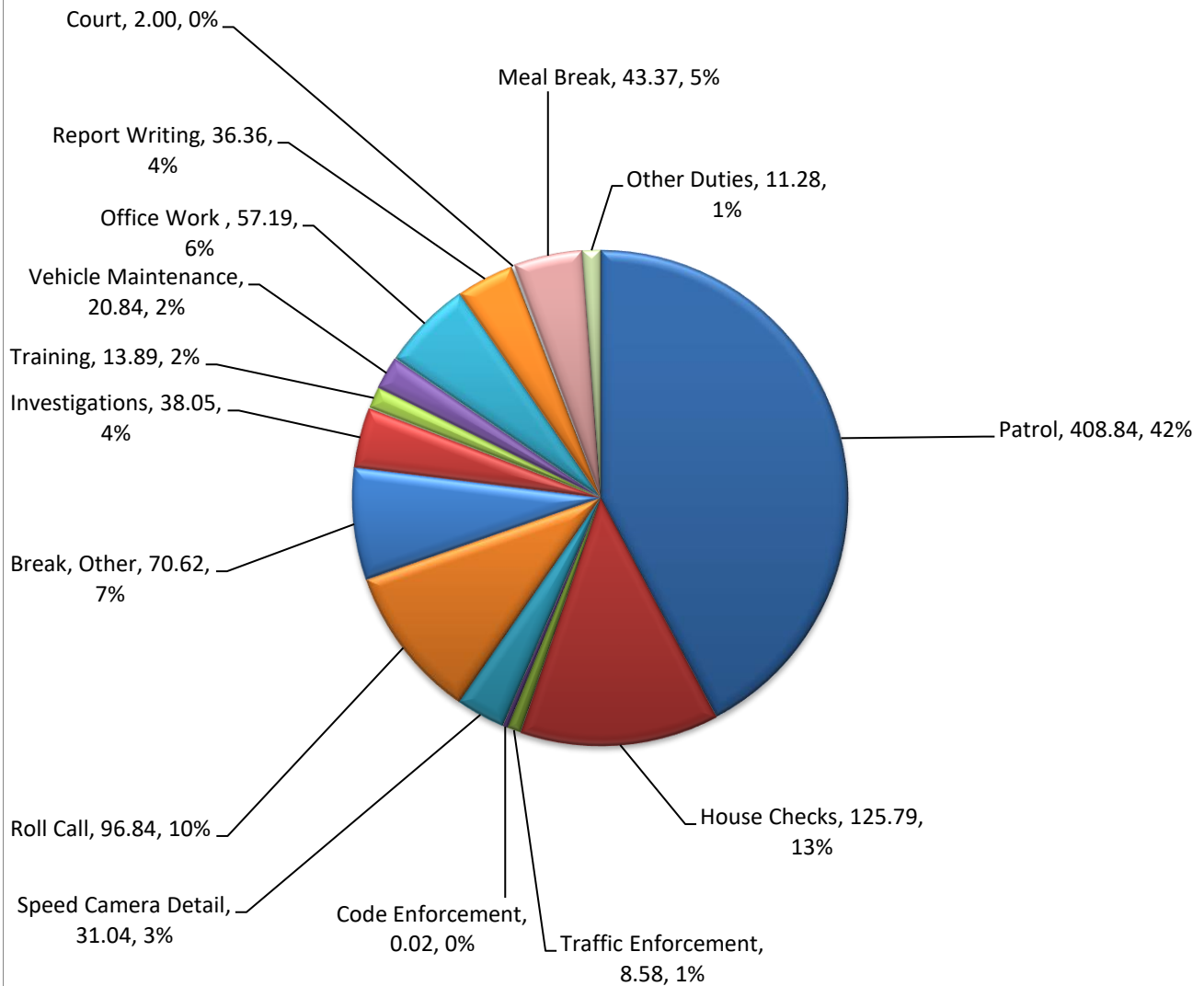

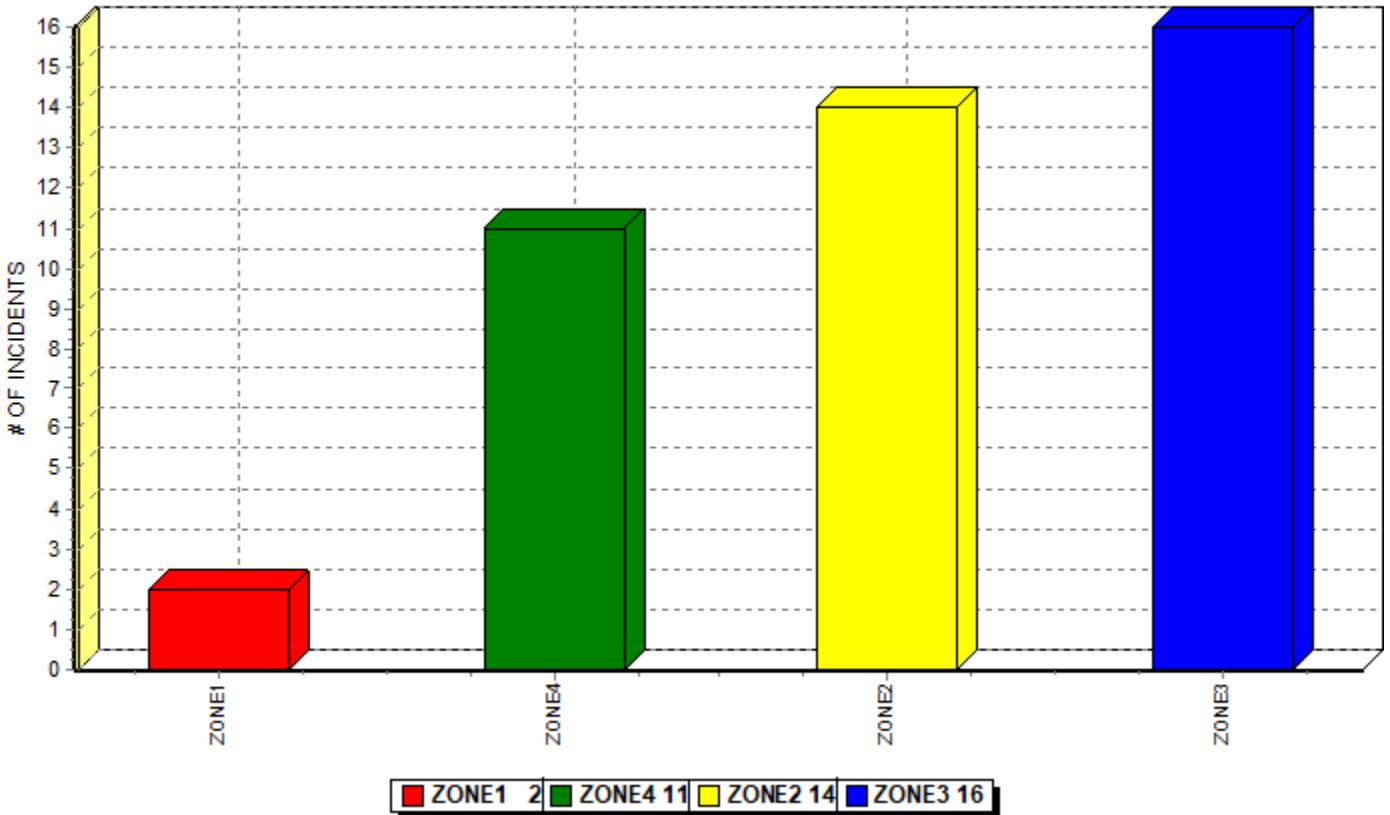

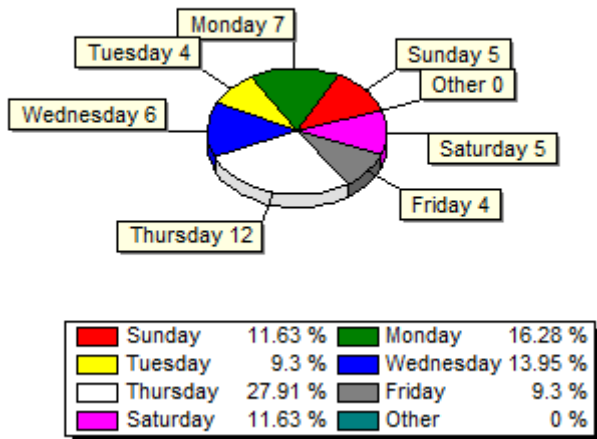

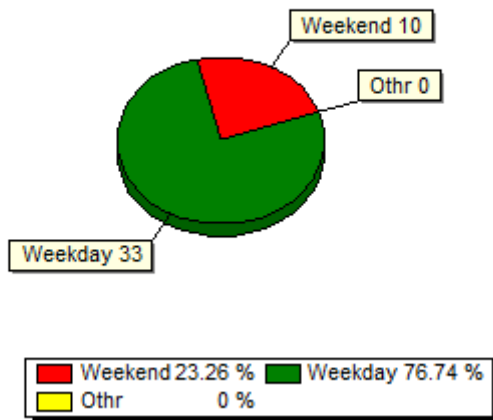
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
