

## September 2017 CCVPD Highlights

### Crime/Operational

1. **Officers conducted two crosswalk enforcement stings in September (20<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>):**  
Violations were video recorded; several citations written.
2. **No thefts or break-ins of any kind were reported in September.**

### Administrative

1. **Location for camera on Oliver at Wisconsin has been identified:**  
Soon, a second camera pad will soon be placed on Oliver Street near Wisconsin Avenue to deter drivers who drive the wrong way on that street and exit onto Wisconsin. We will place a camera identical to the one on Grafton at that location.
2. **Digital parking citations:** We are working to obtain hardware and software to issue digital parking tickets. More to come on this in the near future.
3. **Officers completed annual in-service training at MCPD Academy.**
4. **Fundraiser for Special Olympics of Maryland a success:** Many—including Chief Fitzgerald representing Maryland law enforcement—went ‘Over the Edge’ by rappelling down the 16-story tower at 2 Bethesda Metro Center to raise money for SOMD on 9/30.

### Upcoming

- **Crosswalk sting with MCPD:** Village Police will partner with Montgomery County Police to do another crosswalk enforcement sting later in October; the additional officers will enable us to address more violators

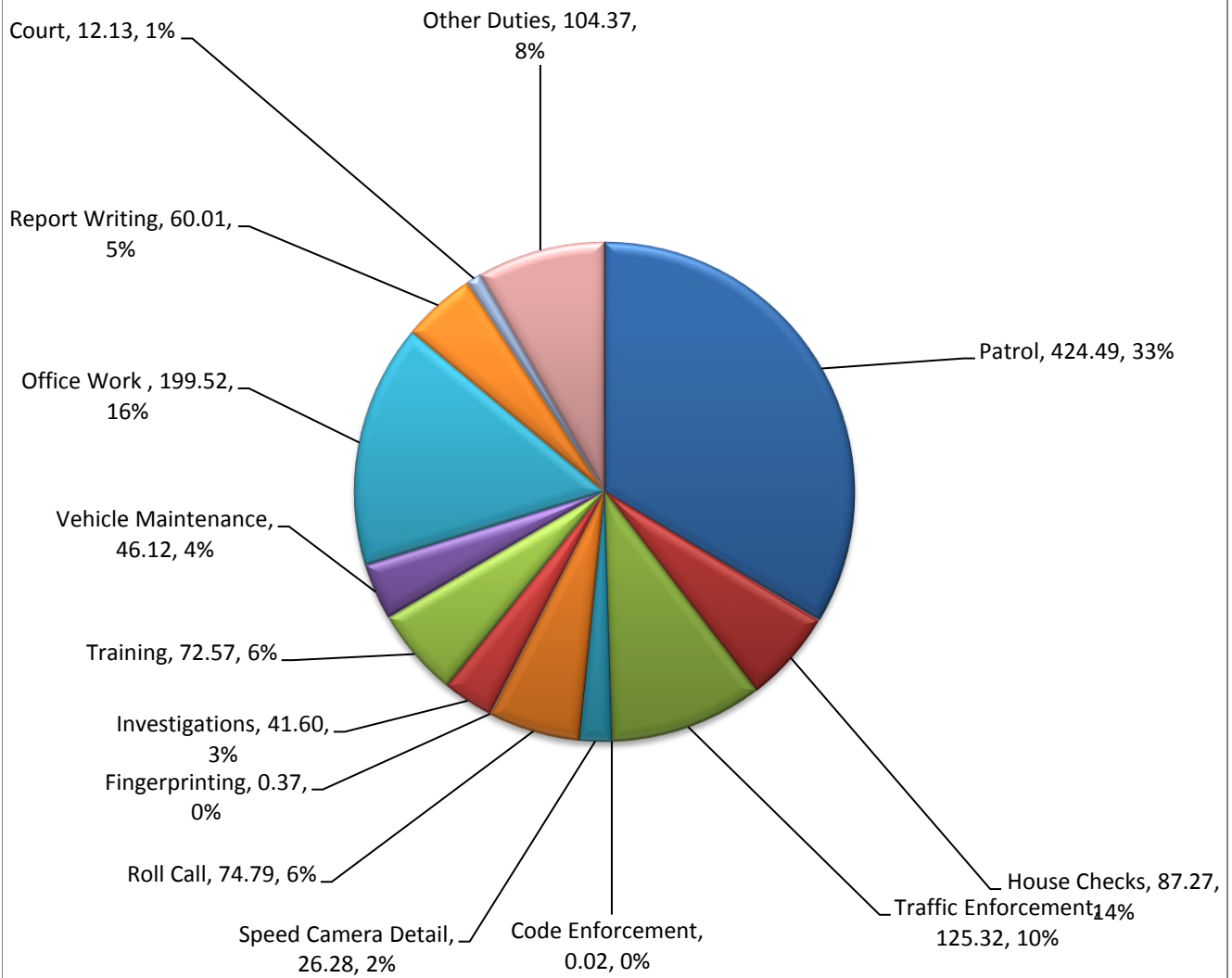

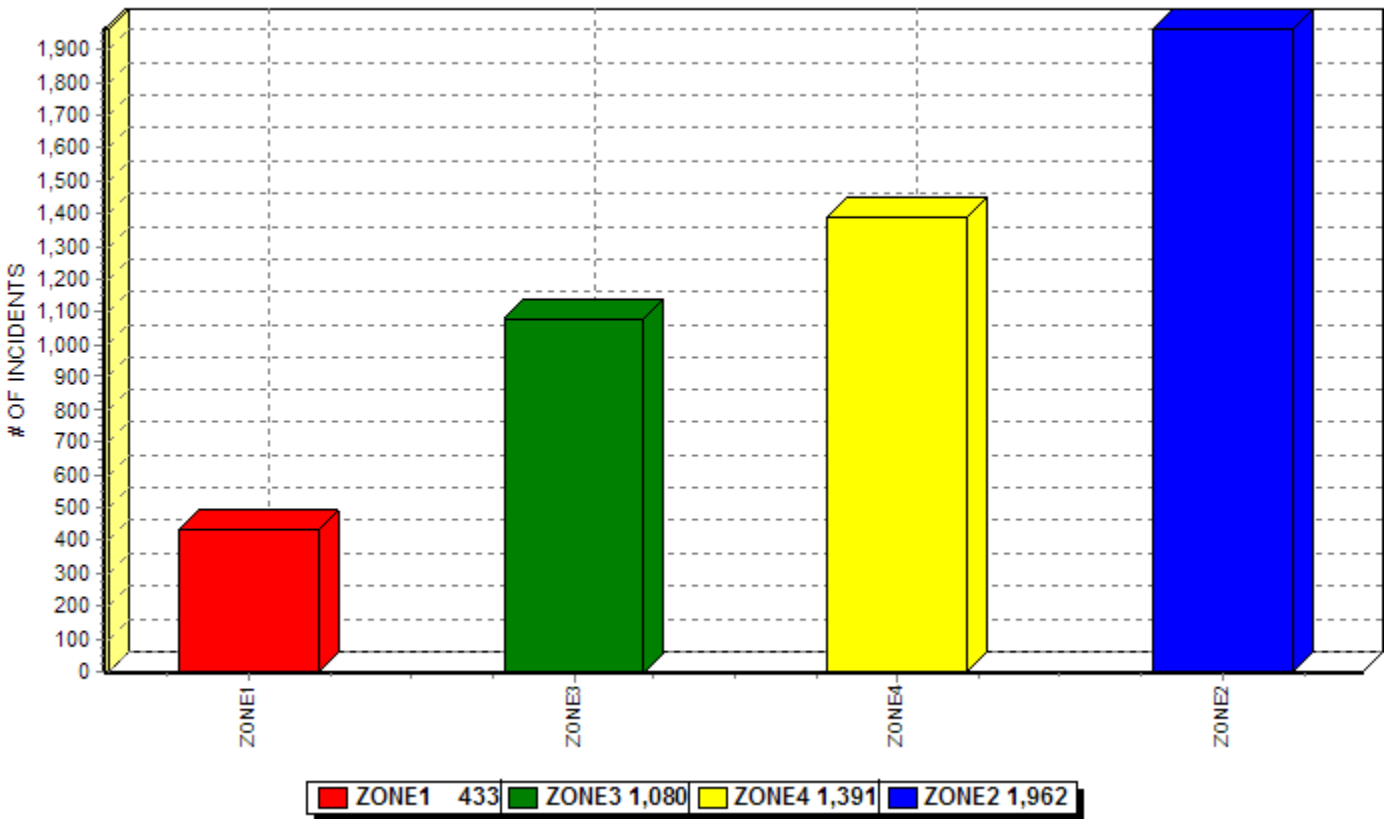

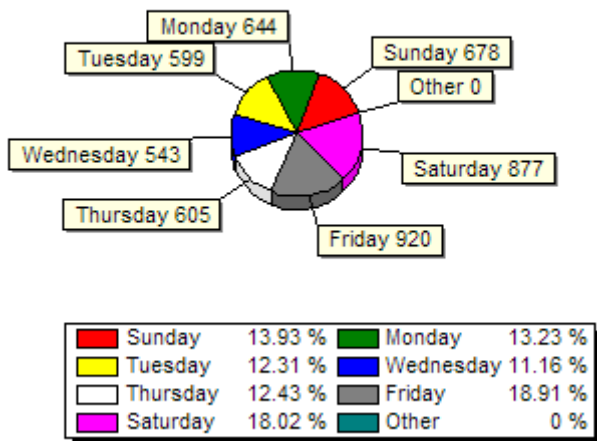

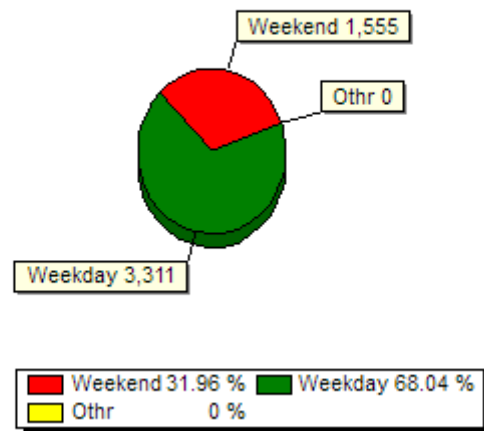
**Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)**
