

October 2017 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. **Village and County Police conducted a joint crosswalk enforcement effort:** On October 24, three Village officers and four County officers worked to write 16 tickets, 2 warnings and 1 equipment repair order in a short time period
2. **Two homes forcibly entered; 1 attempt—all during the day:**
 - 5800 block of Connecticut Avenue on Oct 8: costume jewelry taken
 - Unit block of Newlands Street on Oct 15: attempt; no entry gained
 - 5400 block of Center Street on Oct 16: nothing taken
3. **Second ‘wrong way’ camera installed:** On October 19, our contractor installed and activated a camera on Oliver Street near Wisconsin Avenue to prevent motorists from exiting onto Wisconsin Avenue; the unit is identical to the one on Grafton Street.
4. **We continue to collect data on Grafton and Oliver following the installation of the temporary speed hump.** We should be wrapping this up near the end of November.

Administrative

1. **Officer resigns to take a position with another agency:** On October 27, Officer Deng Tan resigned after 9½ years with the Village to join the Mt. Ranier, MD Police Department; we wish her well and will be recruiting to hire a replacement in the near future.
2. **Digital parking citations:** A draft agreement is being reviewed by Village counsel; we are making progress.
3. **Replacement 3-year speed camera contract:** The agreement is in its final stages and will be ready for the Board’s review for approval in December.

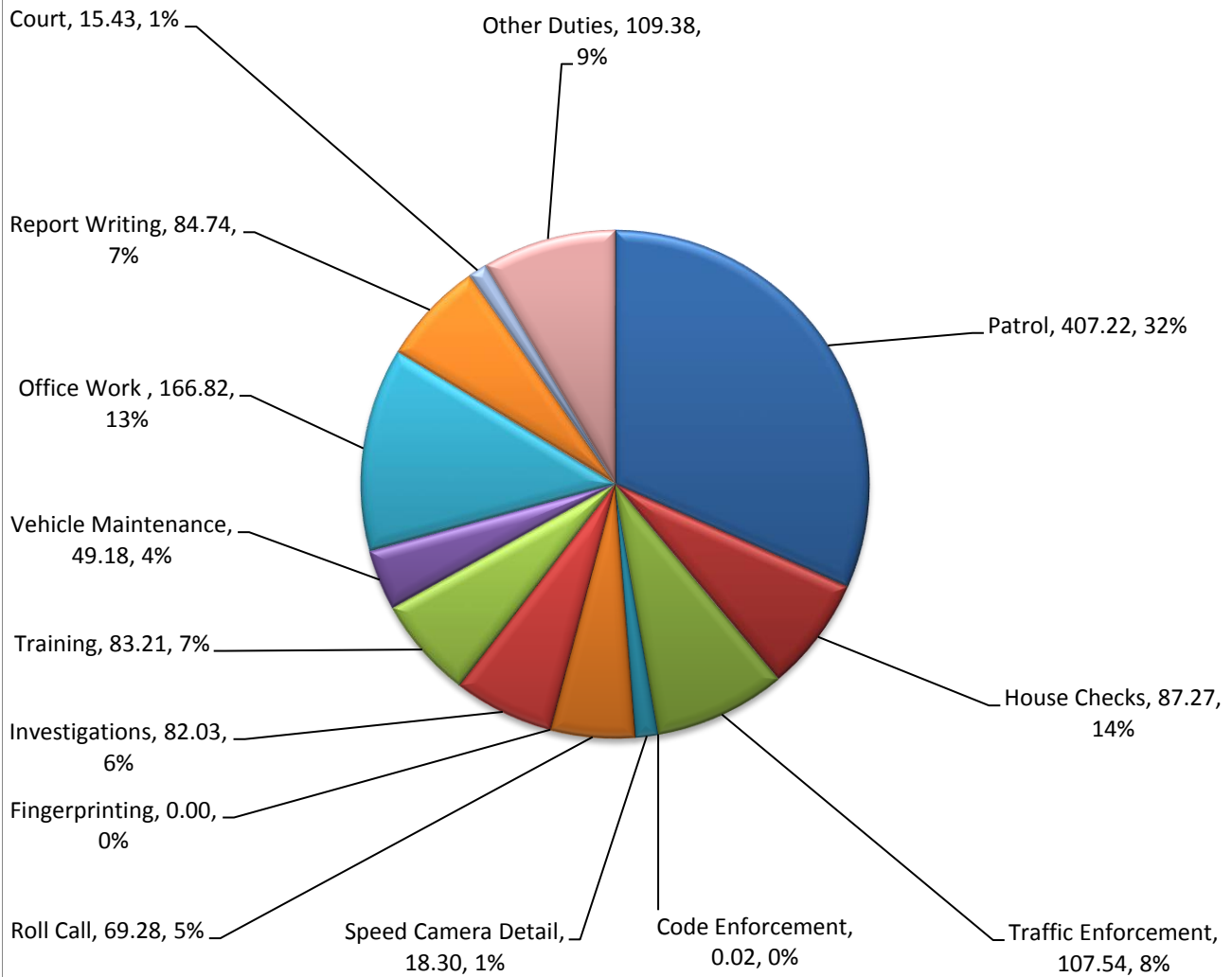

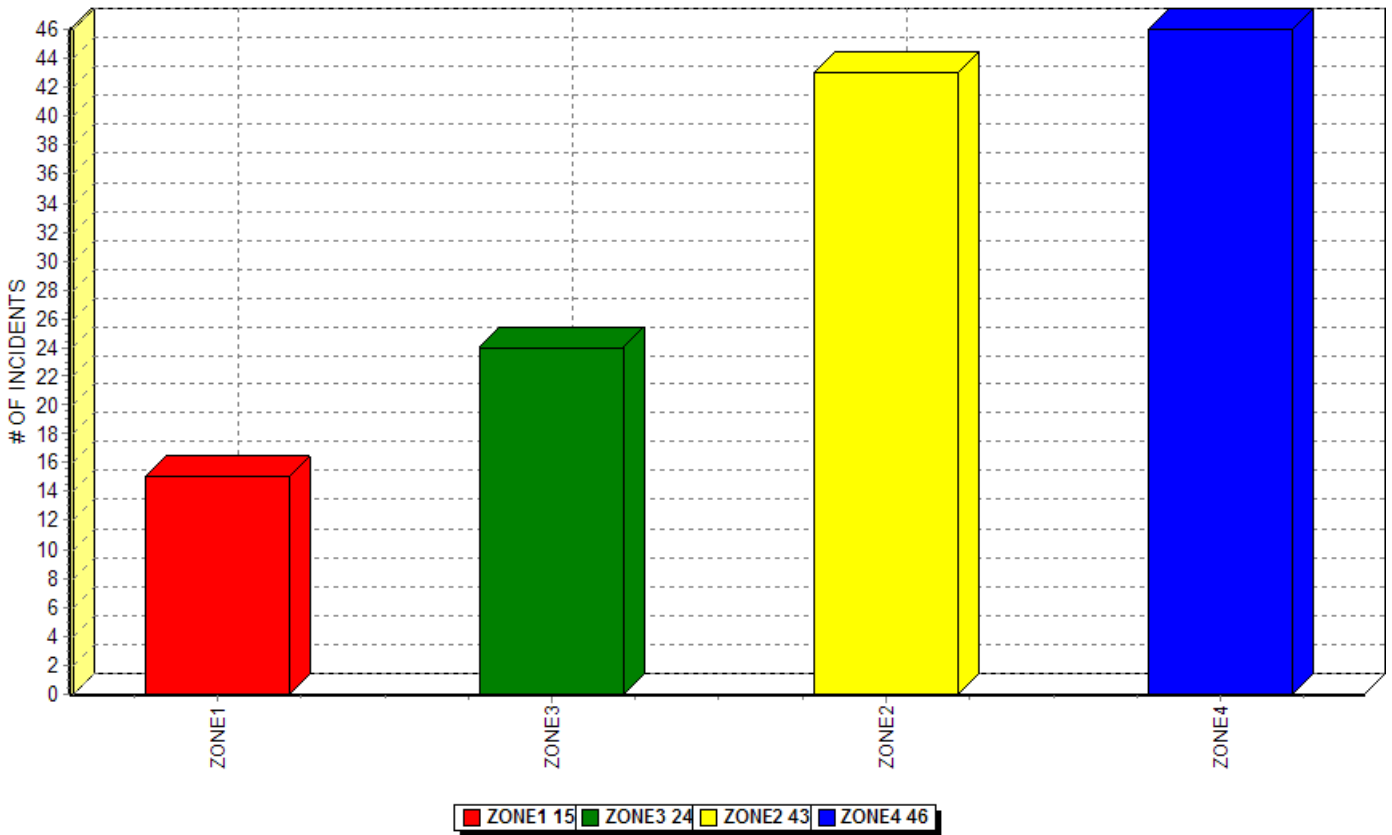

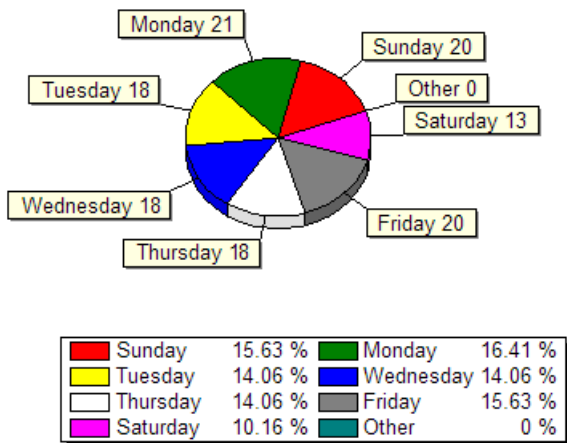

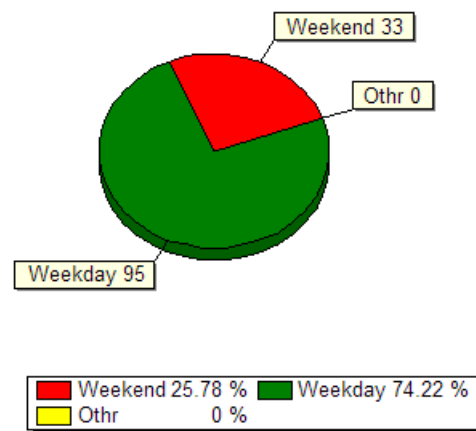
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
