I. Crime/Operational

- We had no reported thefts or burglaries (or any other crimes in the select categories that we track) in February.
- Police (Beverly on dispatch, Officers Chung and Timmerman in patrol) and Public Works staff worked together very effectively in dealing with many downed trees and limbs during the unusual wind storm on Friday 3/2 and Saturday 3/3.
- As a result of a follow-up investigation, Officer Timmerman obtained an arrest warrant charging a man with theft from a construction truck. The suspect is also wanted by the County Police, and he is known by their detectives for being involved in multiple thefts in the area.

II. Administrative

• We have identified a solid candidate to fill our vacant police officer position. Lt. Dasilva is conducting the background investigation now, and we are hopeful that we will be able to make a conditional offer to the prospect in the coming weeks.




