

July 2018 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. **2 DUI arrests following crashes; necessary medical records were subpoenaed in both cases:**
 - On June 29 at 2:30 a.m., a Ford Mustang headed south on Connecticut Avenue at high speed crashed into a tree and came to rest on its side in Chevy Chase Circle; both the driver and passenger suffered severe injuries and were extricated from the car. On July 16, Village Officer Davor Hrnjak served a subpoena on Suburban Hospital to obtain the driver’s medical records which showed that he had a blood alcohol content of 0.26%--more the 3 times the 0.08% threshold for DUI. On July 26, Officer Hrnjak charged the driver with numerous violations.
 - On July 26 shortly after 6:00 a.m., a car heading south on Connecticut Avenue struck the rear of a car stopped at the Circle; this second car then struck the rear of a third stopped car (chain reaction). Village Officer Joseph Chung responded and investigated. After conducting roadside tests, Officer Chung arrested the man. He was taken by ambulance to Suburban Hospital for an unrelated medical condition where he refused to allow his blood to be taken for evidentiary purposes. On August 6, Officer Chung served a subpoena on Suburban Hospital for the driver’s medical records; once the records are obtained, appropriate charges will be placed.
2. **6 unlocked cars entered; nothing taken from 4 of them:**
 - 4000 block of Oliver; iPhone and wallet containing \$900 taken
 - W. Irving between Magnolia and Cedar; \$10 in coins, tennis gear taken
 - Middle block of Hesketh Street; nothing taken
 - 100 block of Summerfield (2 cars); nothing taken
 - 5500 block of Grove Street; nothing taken
3. **Pro-life demonstrators displayed graphic signs from 4:30-6:30 p.m. on July 24;** we received 3 calls complaining of the group; no other problems.

Administrative

- **Chief, along with a small leadership group from Maryland Chiefs and Sheriffs, met with Maryland Medical Cannabis Commission executive director and her staff.** We proposed changes to the regulations to enable law enforcement to distinguish between lawful medical marijuana possession and illegal marijuana possession.

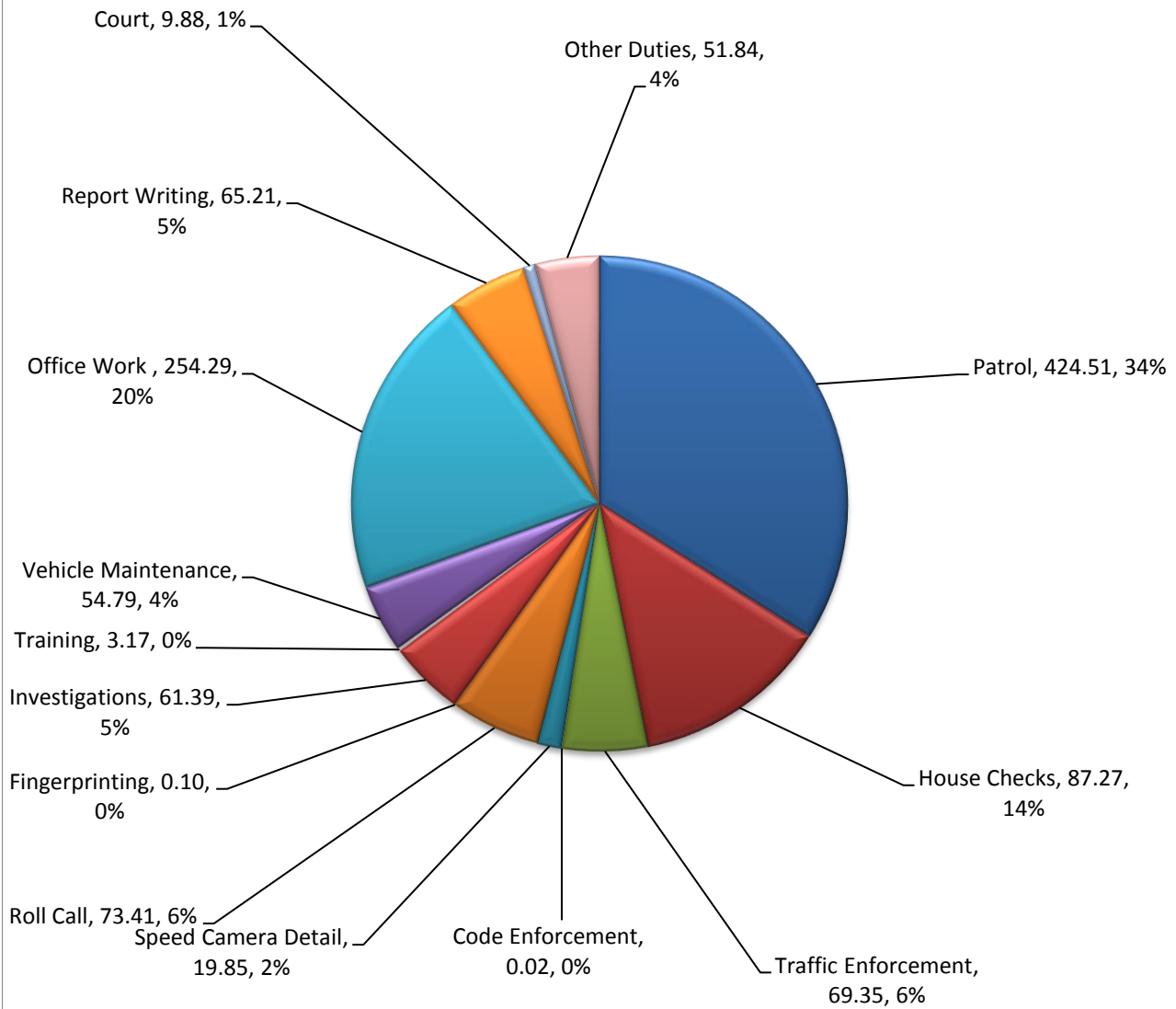

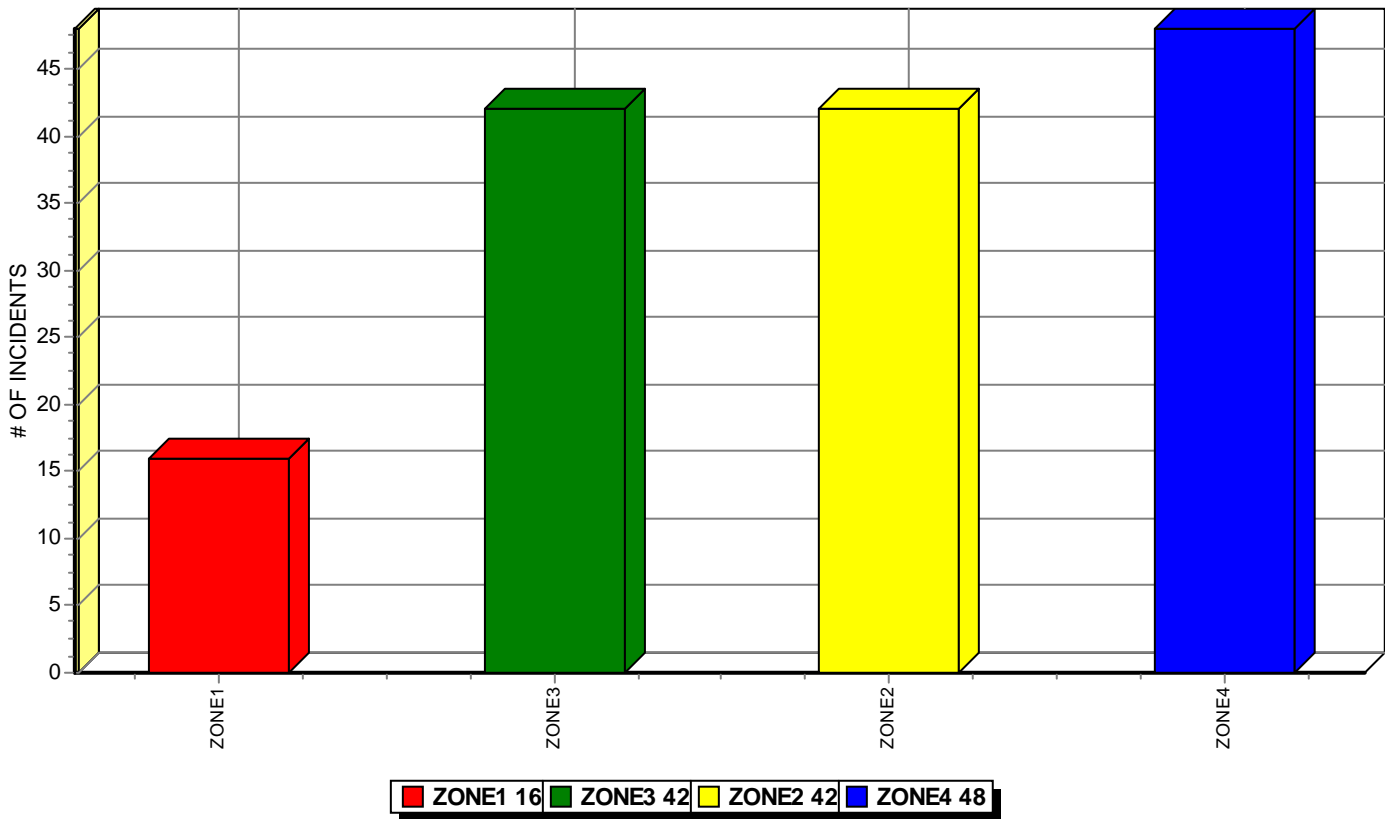

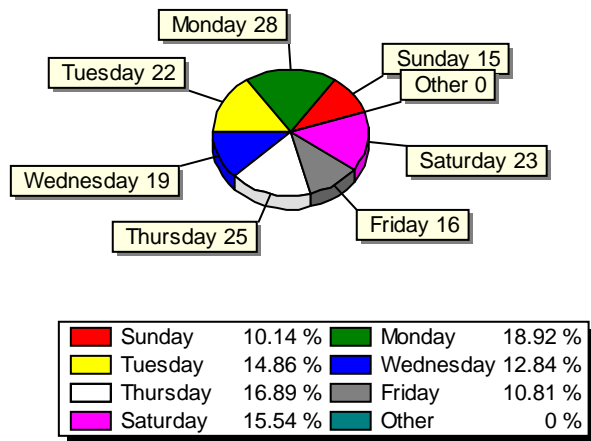

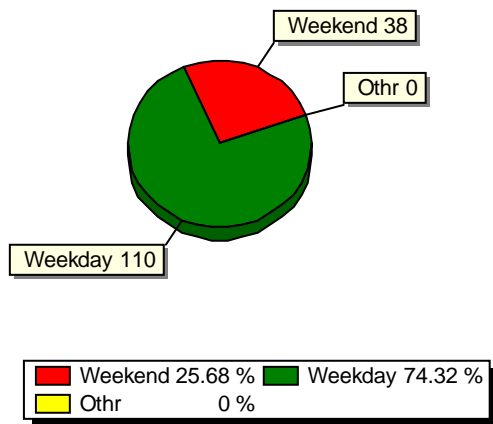
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
