

September 2018 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

- **No reported thefts from autos in September**
- **Theft from an unlocked garage:** Magnolia Parkway between W. Kirke and W. Lenox; during a 2-week period when the residents were away, a cordless lawn mower and a cordless trimmer were taken from the unlocked detached garage

Administrative/Training

- On September 19, we held an ‘all hands’ meeting of Department personnel which includes police officers and communications clerks. We presented training on the new laws that would take effect on October 1 and we discussed several other items of importance (policies, current events, budget items, etc.).
- Chief Fitzgerald and three other police leaders provided four training sessions in September at locations around the state to help law enforcement agencies prepare for some important new laws (Extreme Risk Protective Orders; Firearms Transfer on Conviction; Arrests for Violations of Conditions of Release) that went into effect on October 1.
- Half of our officers fulfilled their annual in-service training mandate in September; the remainder of our officers are scheduled to complete their training in October.

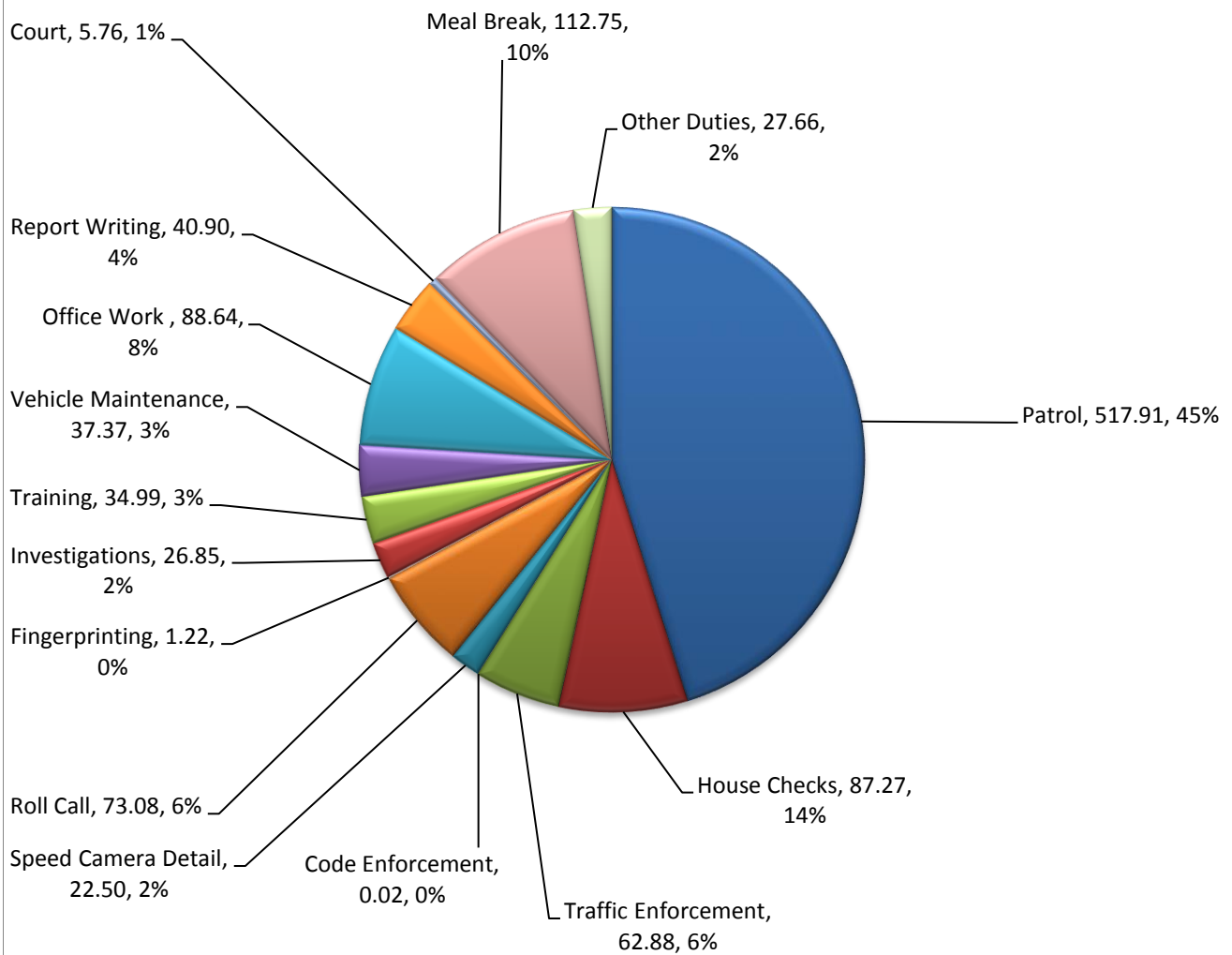

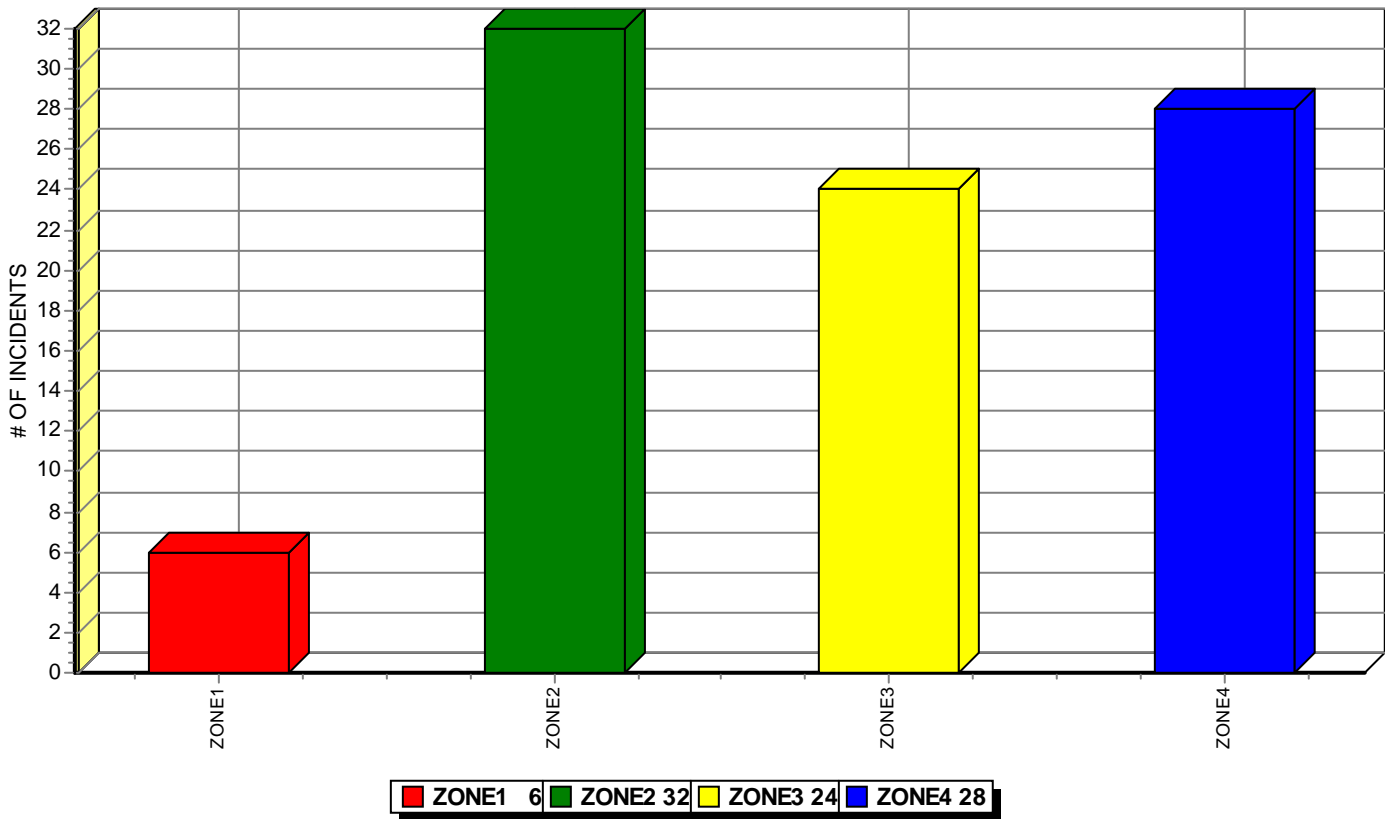

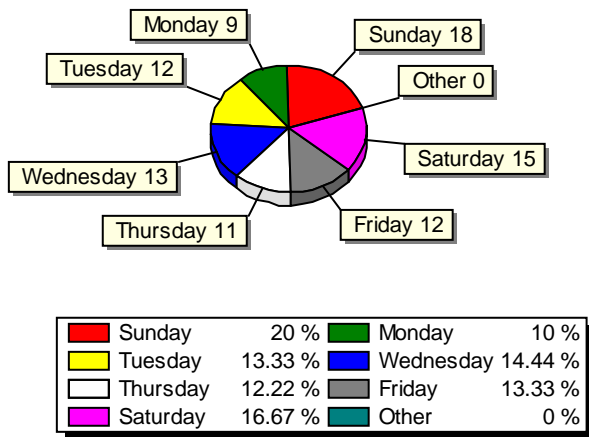

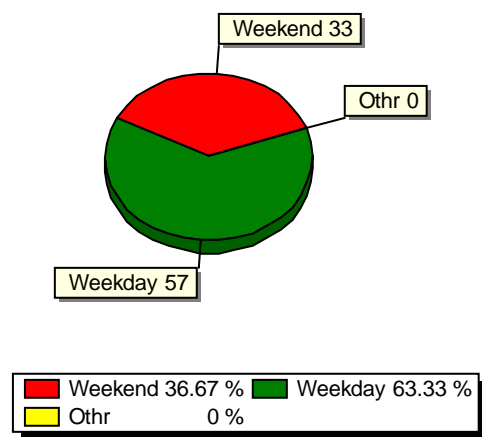
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
