

December 2018 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. **Car (with key inside) stolen overnight and recovered later the same day on December 4.** A resident awoke to find her minivan missing from her driveway in the 6300 block of Broad Branch Road. Village officers worked with the victim to activate the manufacturer’s GPS location software which indicated that the car was in DC. Village police sent DC police to the location, and Village Officer Timmerman drove the victim to her car where she was able to recover it and drive it home. Side note—the same thieves also stole a bicycle from the unlocked garage of a nearby neighbor’s home.

2. **4 construction trucks and a resident’s car entered during the day on December 11; no suspects seen.**
 - 4000 block of Oliver: Smashed window, tablet taken from pest control truck
 - 3900 block of Oliver: wallet taken from unlocked work van
 - 5600 block of Montgomery: phone taken from unlocked landscaper’s truck
 - W. Irving near Cedar: Smashed window, backpack taken from landscaper’s truck
 - Laurel Parkway: Resident’s purse taken from unattended and open car

3. **Unattended leaf blower stolen on Newlands Street on December 23.** At about 11:30 a.m., a worker unloaded a backpack-style leaf blower from his truck and walked away for about 10 minutes. When he returned, the leaf blower was gone. He saw no one.

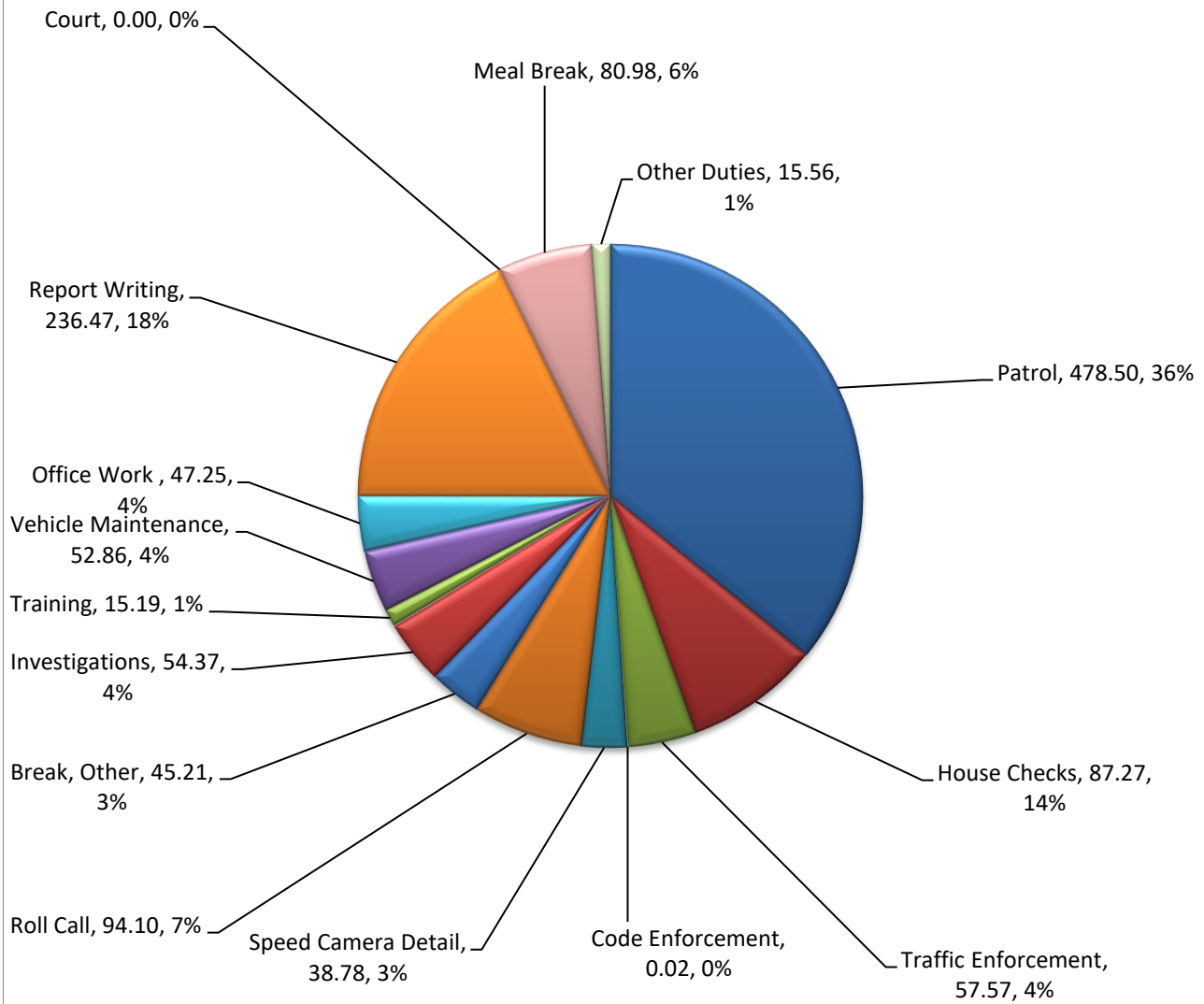

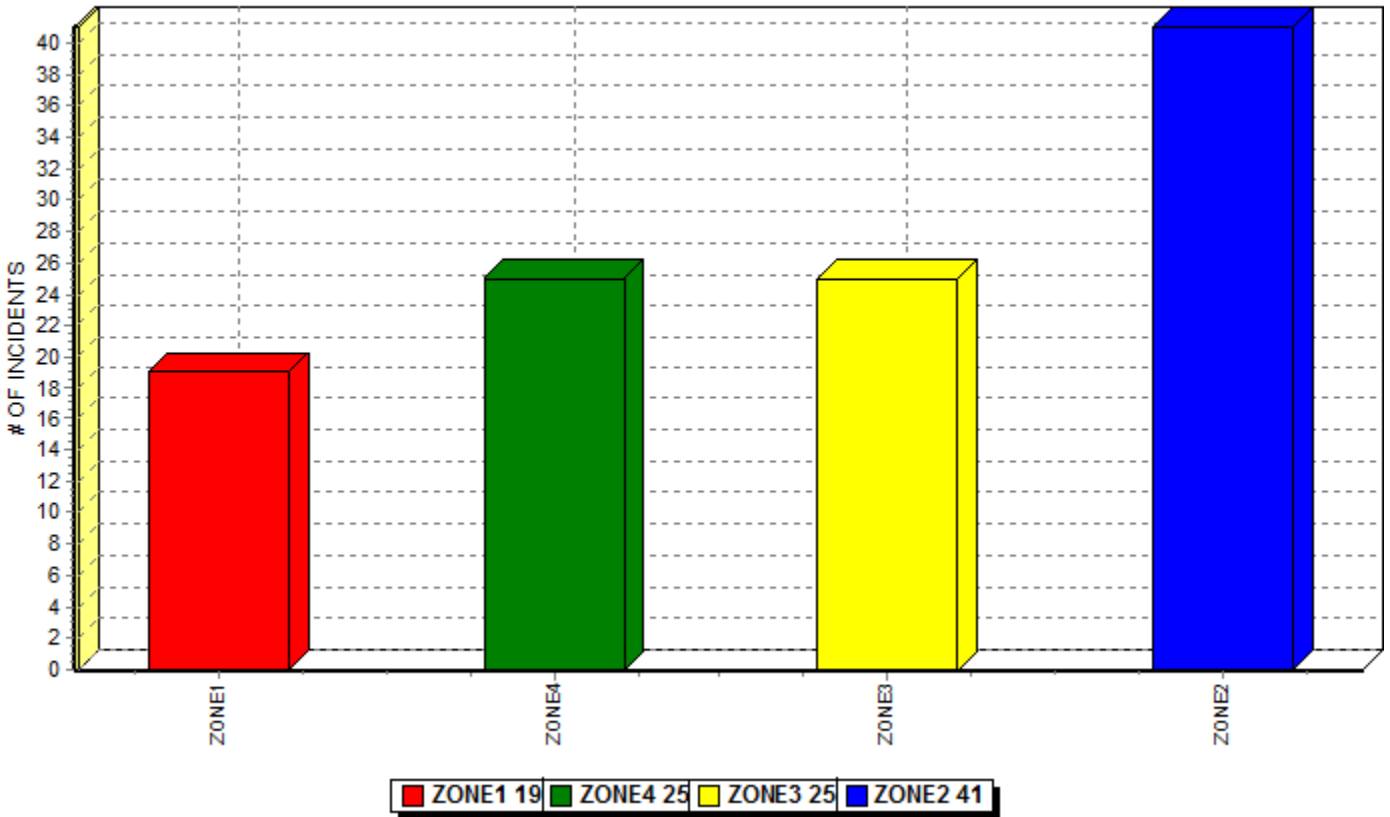

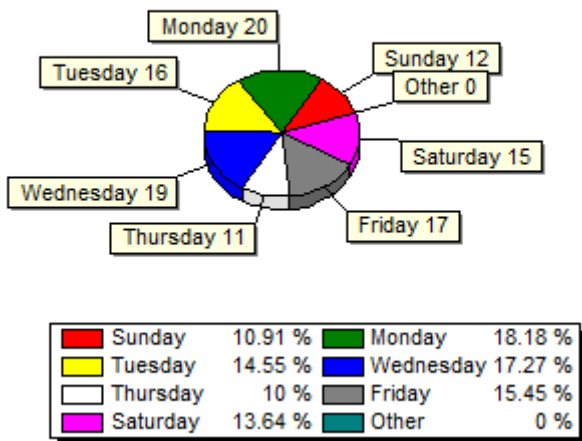

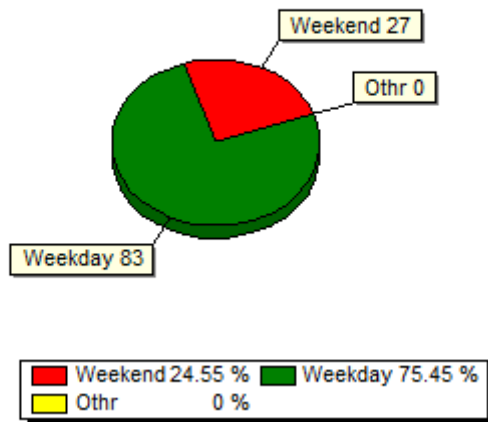
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
