

January 2019 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. Nighttime activity

- Between January 1 and January 6, four cars were entered. Locations were the unit blocks of Oxford and Newlands, and the 100 block of Primrose. Three were unlocked (coins stolen from two of them, nothing taken from the third), one had a window broken by a brick (duffel bag containing clothing taken, but discarded on the street and returned to the owner).
- At 3:00 a.m. on January 8, 2 thieves opened an unlocked car in the 5500 block of Grove Street and used the garage door opener to raise the garage door; once inside the garage, the thieves took a \$1,000 bicycle and left the scene. Officers discovered 3 additional unlocked cars entered (two on the same block of Grove, one in the 5500 block of Center)—nothing taken from 2 of them, coins taken from the third.
- An unsecured house under construction in the 5500 block of Park Street was entered over the weekend of January 18-20; construction tools were taken. Foreman said many workers are assigned to the job and he believes the thief was someone with inside knowledge.

3. Daytime activity

- On January 3 at about 3:30 p.m., a worker reported that he had left his car unattended for about an hour with the key inside in the 100 block of E. Lenox Street; the car was taken and there were no eyewitnesses. The car was recovered on January 11 in Prince George’s County. During the investigation, officers discovered that two unlocked work trucks had been entered in the immediate area resulting in several cell phones, cash and a wallet stolen; no suspects seen.
- On January 29 at 2:20 p.m., officers responded to an alarm call in the 100 block of Primrose Street. The front door had been kicked and damaged, but the individual did not enter the home. Nothing taken.

Administrative

- Chief Fitzgerald and the Village Manager, Ms. Shana Davis-Cook, met with 15 residents from Newlands Street to discuss the residents’ concerns about traffic on their street.
- Chief Fitzgerald was elected to serve as the 2nd VP for the Maryland Chiefs of Police Association—a volunteer position to help guide the organization.

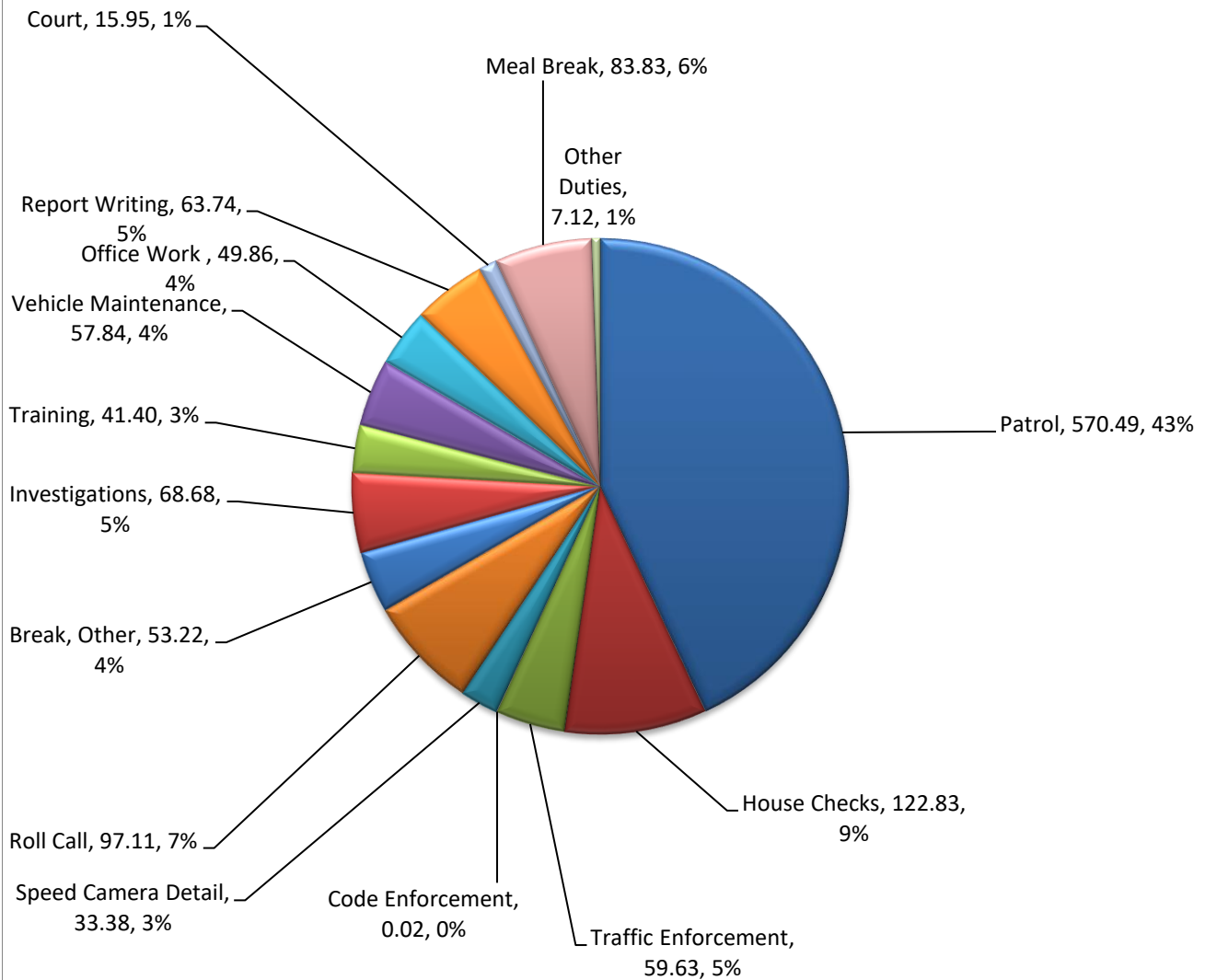

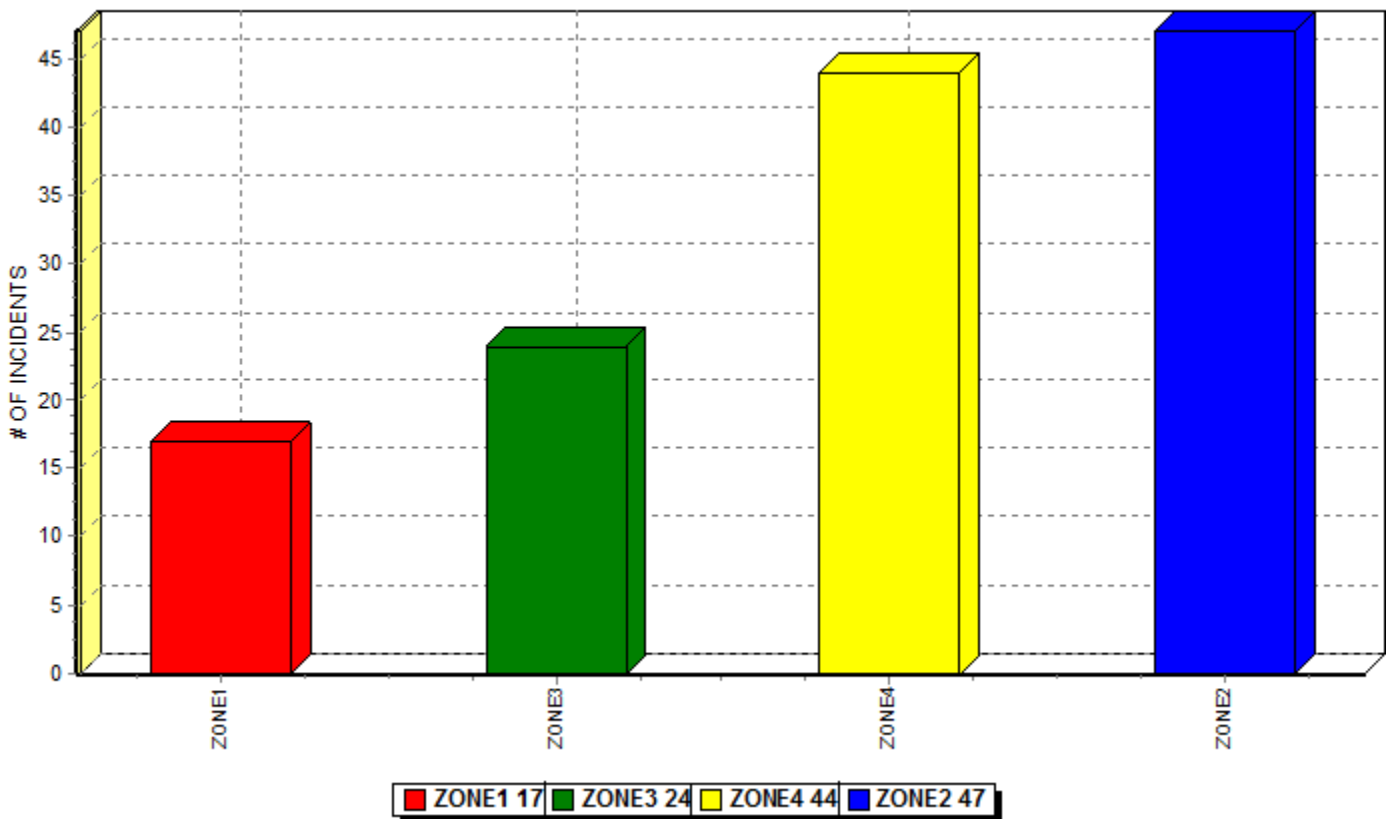

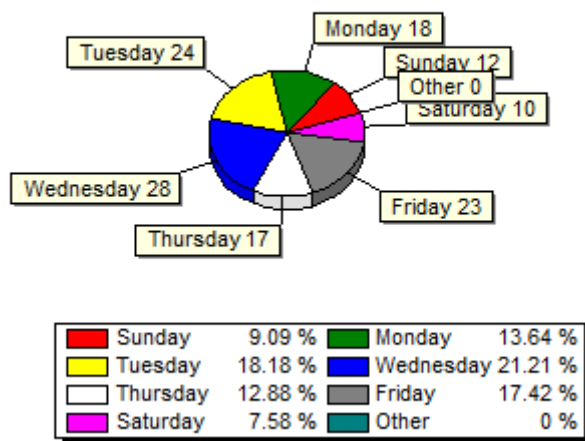

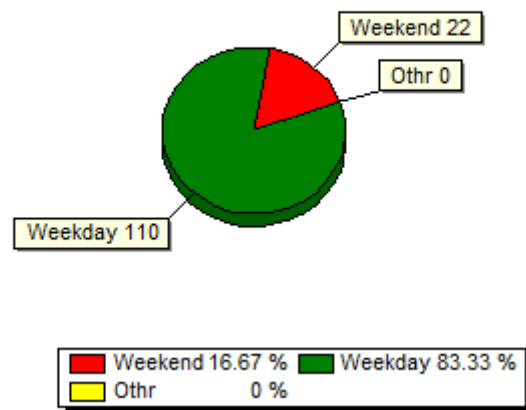
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
