Crime/Operational

- 1. Officer Patterson discovers 5 unlocked autos entered in the middle of the night: Officer Patterson spotted a purse sitting on the trunk of a car at 4:15 a.m. on the unit block of Hesketh on March 11; he and his partner, Officer Willie Hearn, ultimately found five cars that were disturbed. Nothing taken from three of the cars, loose change from a fourth, and the purse from the final car. Four cars were on the unit block of Hesketh, one was on the middle block of Grafton. The purse was returned to its owner.
- 2. **2 unlocked cars entered overnight 3/11-3/12:** nothing taken from a car in the 5500 block of Center Street, loose change taken from a car on Grafton between Cedar and Kirkside.
- 3. **Unlocked work trucks entered in the daytime; tools taken:** Between 3/21 and 3/25, three unlocked work trucks were entered and tools were taken from two of them; nothing from the third. DC, Montgomery County, and Village officers continue to work to identify and arrest these thieves who work in groups, hit multiple locations, and often use recently stolen cars.

Administrative/Personnel

- 1. Ms. Dana Orth, one of our overnight dispatchers, has announced that she will be resigning in May and joining her recently-retired husband in a life of leisure. She has been with us for 18 months, and she's been a pleasure. We have begun recruiting for her replacement.
- 2. Officer Davor Hrnjak, one of our 4 nighttime officers, injured his back while off duty about 2 weeks ago. He is recovering and currently is in a light-duty status and is completing several administrative tasks that have been pending. He is eager to return to patrol and is expected to return to full duty in the coming weeks.




