Crime/Operational

1. **Three bicycles taken from unsecured garage:** Resident of the 4000 block of Oliver Street discovered that 3 bicycles had been taken from the detached, unsecured garage while the family was away for 3 weeks.
2. **No thefts from autos this month.**
3. **Valuable jewelry stolen from inside a resident's home; jewelry last seen 4 months ago:** Resident was in the process of moving and discovered missing jewelry. Many persons were in the home during the 4-month time frame; resident has no idea who could be responsible.

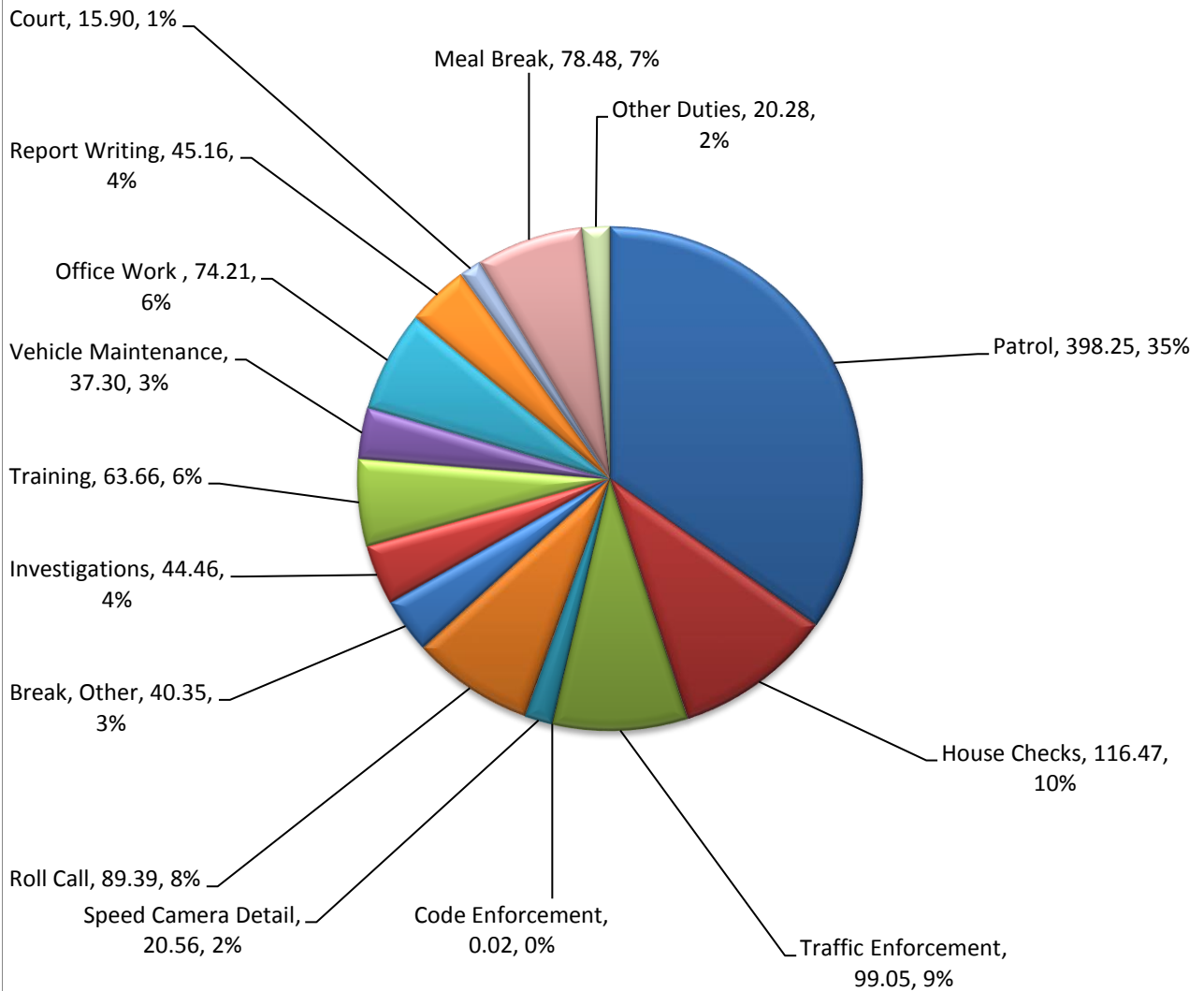

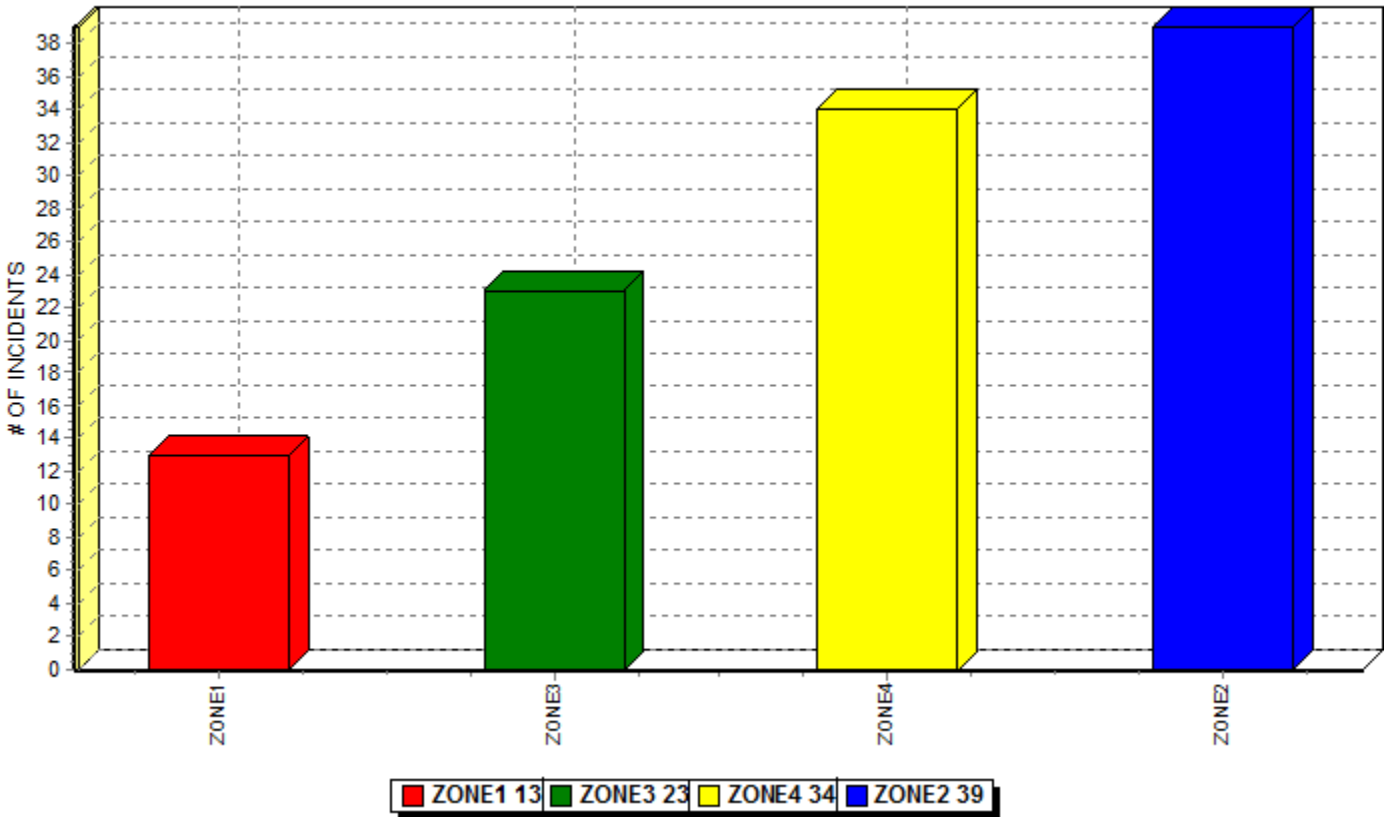

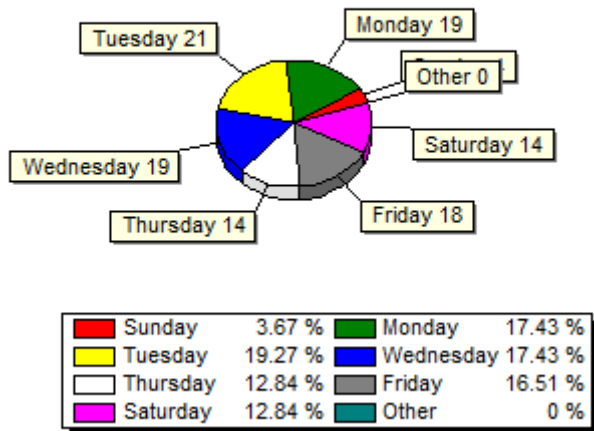

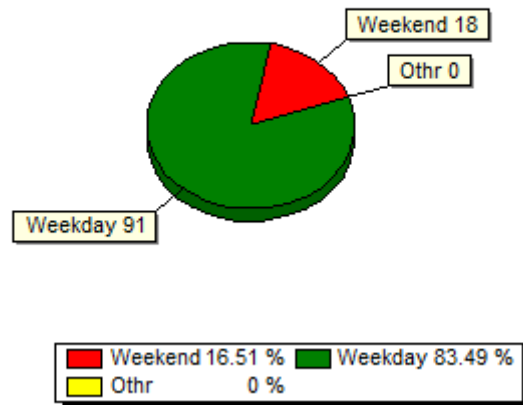
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
