

May 2019 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. **Unlocked home entered by apparently inebriated man:** Resident of the Chevy Chase Circle was awakened by her barking dog at about 1:00 a.m. on May 28. Upon investigation, the homeowner discovered a young (20-25 years old) man in her kitchen. He appeared to be drunk and stated that he was looking for an Uber. He walked out without committing any crime.
2. **No thefts from autos this month.**

Administrative/Personnel

1. Training accomplished this month (all training was tuition-free):
 - Officer Hrnjak completed a 40-hour crime scene processing course
 - Officer Timmerman completed a 40-hour investigations course
 - Lt. Dasilva, Sgt. Tiedemann and Officer Hrnjak completed a 1-day state-mandated refresher training to continue as certified field training officers/supervisors
 - Officer Patterson completed a 40-hour course as a patrol rifle operator
 - Officers Perper and Hrnjak attended Implicit Bias training
 - All officers attended state-mandated in-service training
 - Two more officers attended Implicit Bias training in April; two more will attend in May. All will eventually receive this training.
2. On May 10, Chief Fitzgerald met with All Saints Church officials to assist them in establishing protocols for emergencies that may occur at the facility.

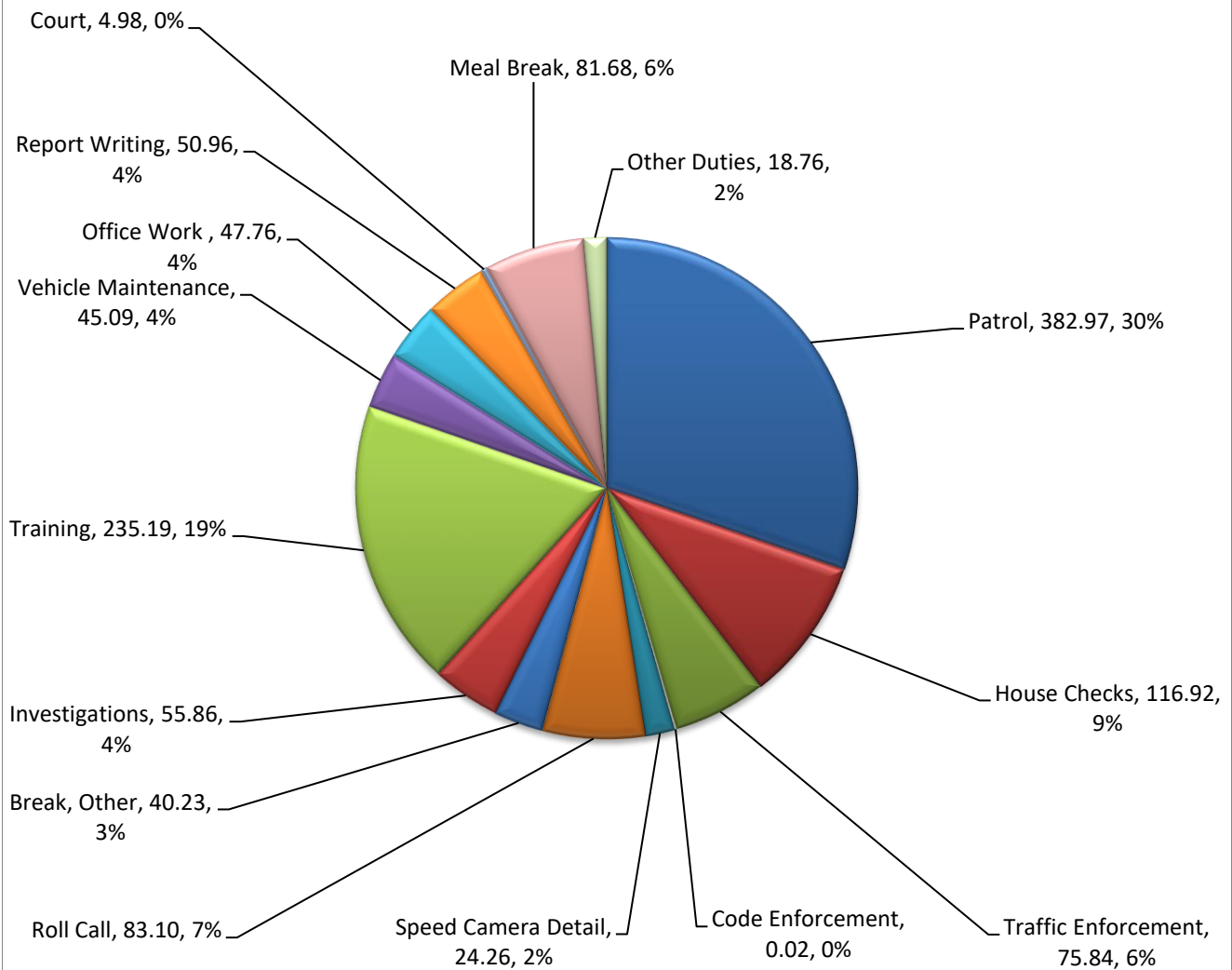
