Crime/Operational

1. No thefts from autos this month

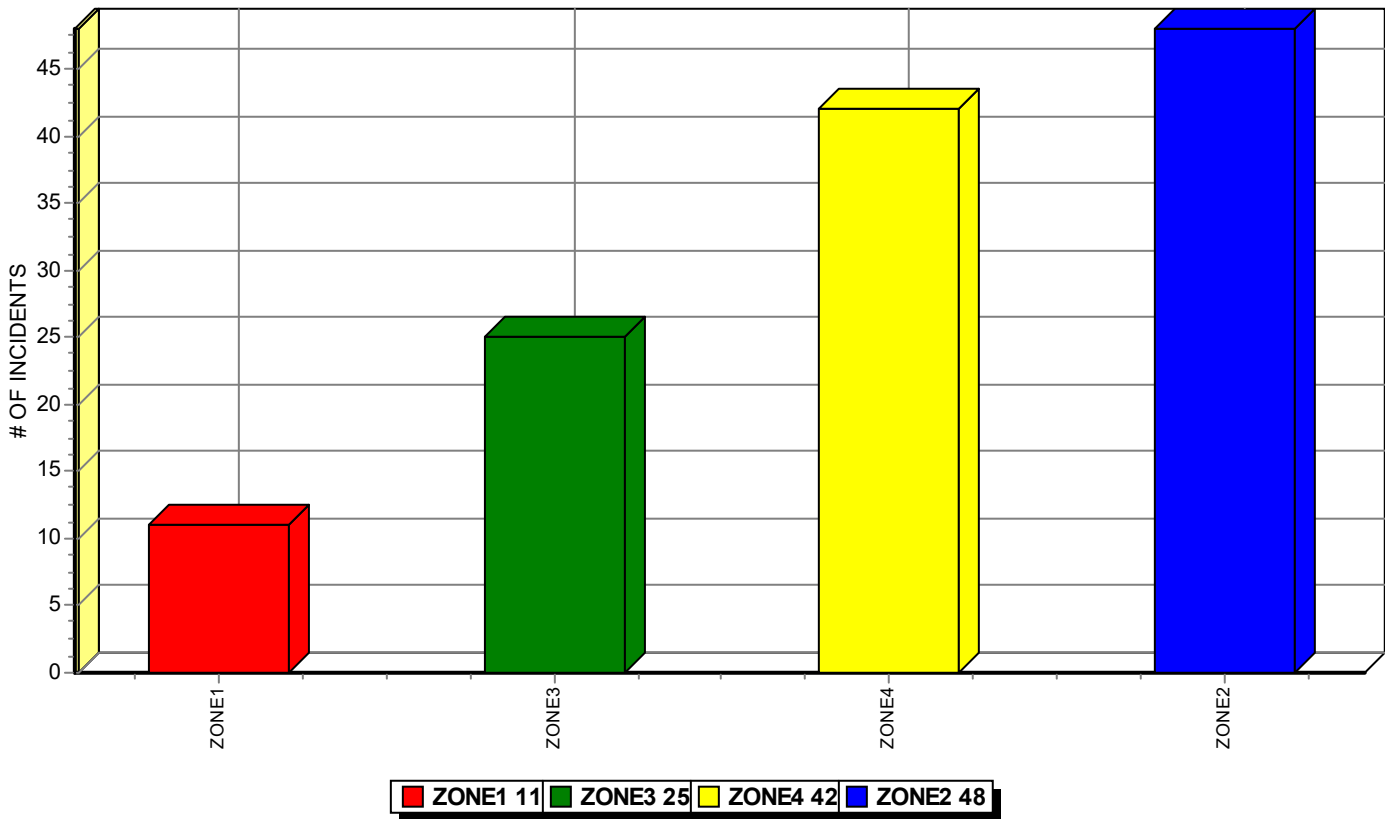

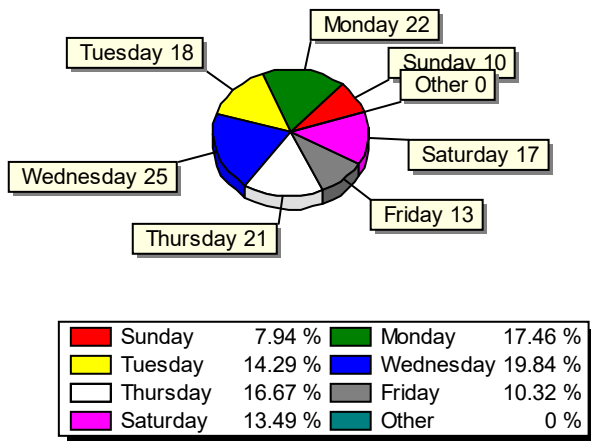

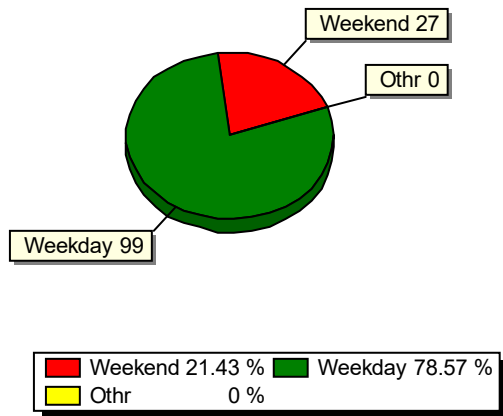
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
