Crime/Operational

One bicycle taken from an unlocked garage and six cars entered at nighttime: five cars were unlocked, one car had a window broken:

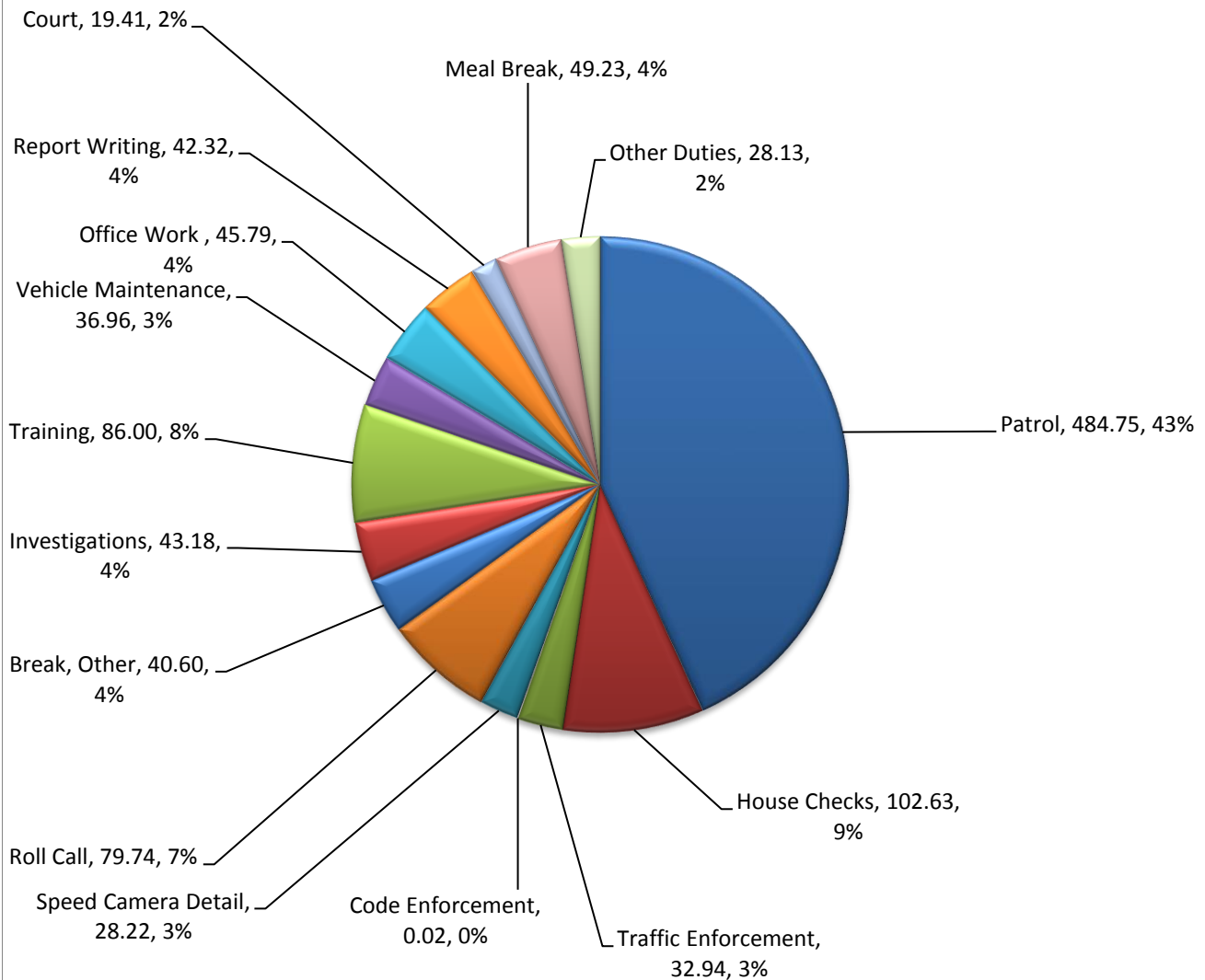

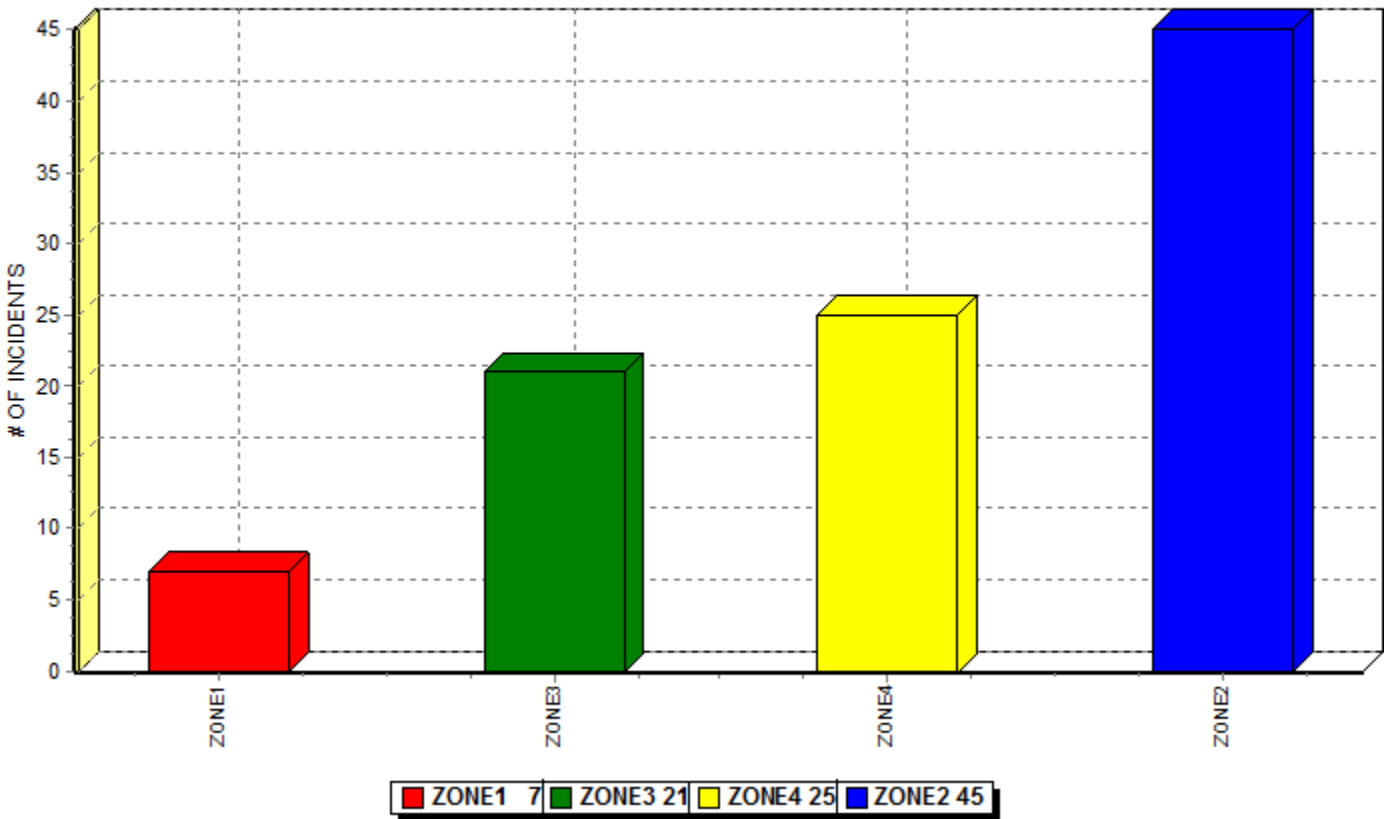

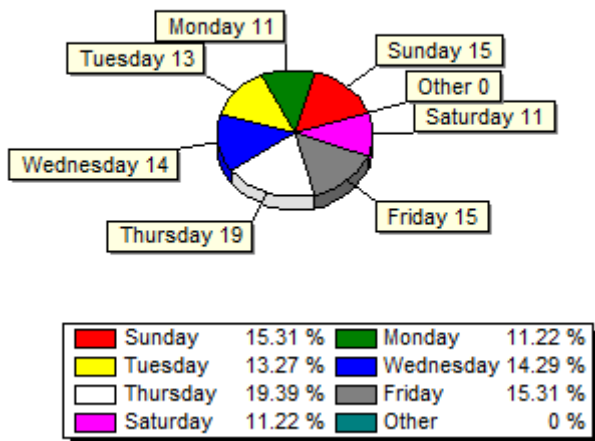

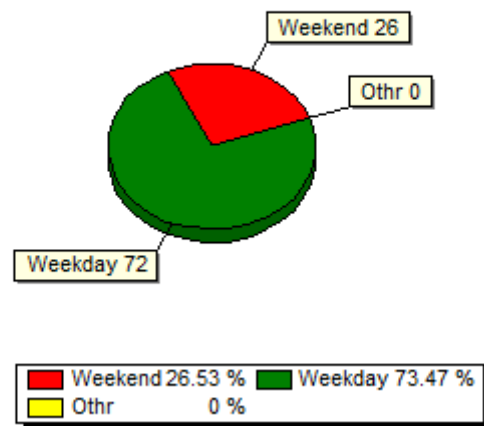
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
