

December 2019 CCVPD Highlights

I. Crime/Operational

1. **On-scene arrest for attempted theft:** On December 6 just before midnight, Officer Drew Fones spotted a strange man inside a resident's car. Officer Fones knew the resident, so Fones was immediately suspicious. After confirming that the suspect was unknown to the resident, Officer Fones arrested Joshua Hernandez, 31, of Washington, DC, and charged him with breaking and entering a motor vehicle and attempted theft.
2. **On-scene arrest for package theft:** On December 21, Officers Chung and Timmerman responded to a call for a package thief who had just been seen stealing from a porch on Grove Street. The officers arrived within minutes, located the man, and arrested Maurice Smith, 40, of no fixed address and charged him with theft. Several residents witnessed portions of the crime and helped the officers piece things together and recover the stolen item.
3. **Burglary on W. Lenox between Laurel Parkway and the dead end:** While the resident was away over the holiday, unknown person(s) entered through the unlocked rear sliding door between December 27 and 28 and stole items of value. County police detectives are conducting the follow-up investigation.
4. **Package thefts reported:**
 - Grafton between Kirkside and Wisconsin (Dec 11)
 - Hesketh Street between Magnolia and Cedar (Dec 24)

II. Administrative/Personnel

Dispatcher resignation: Ms. Racara Sawyer, one of our nighttime dispatchers, is resigning to take a job elsewhere. We have begun a recruitment effort to replace her.

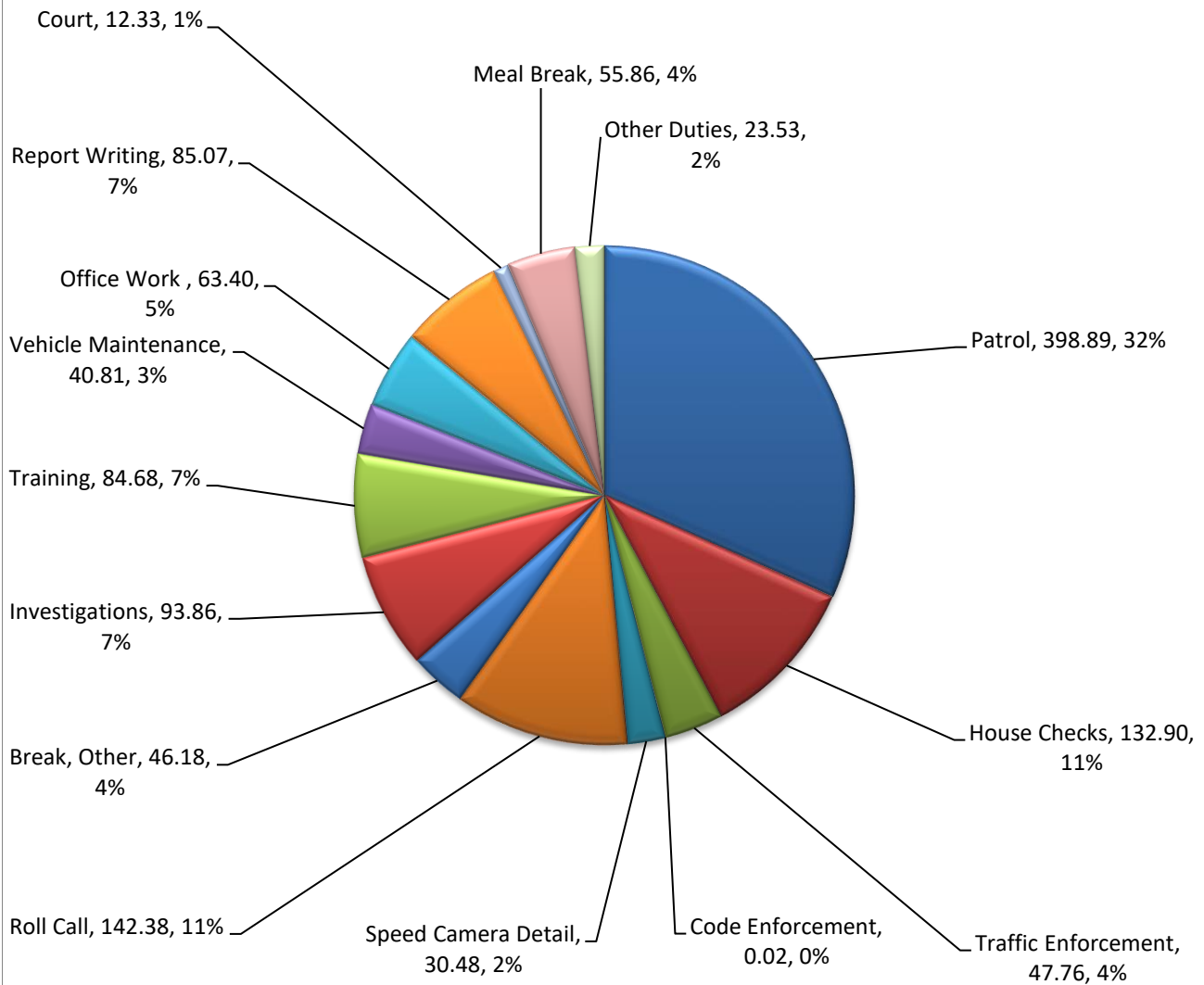

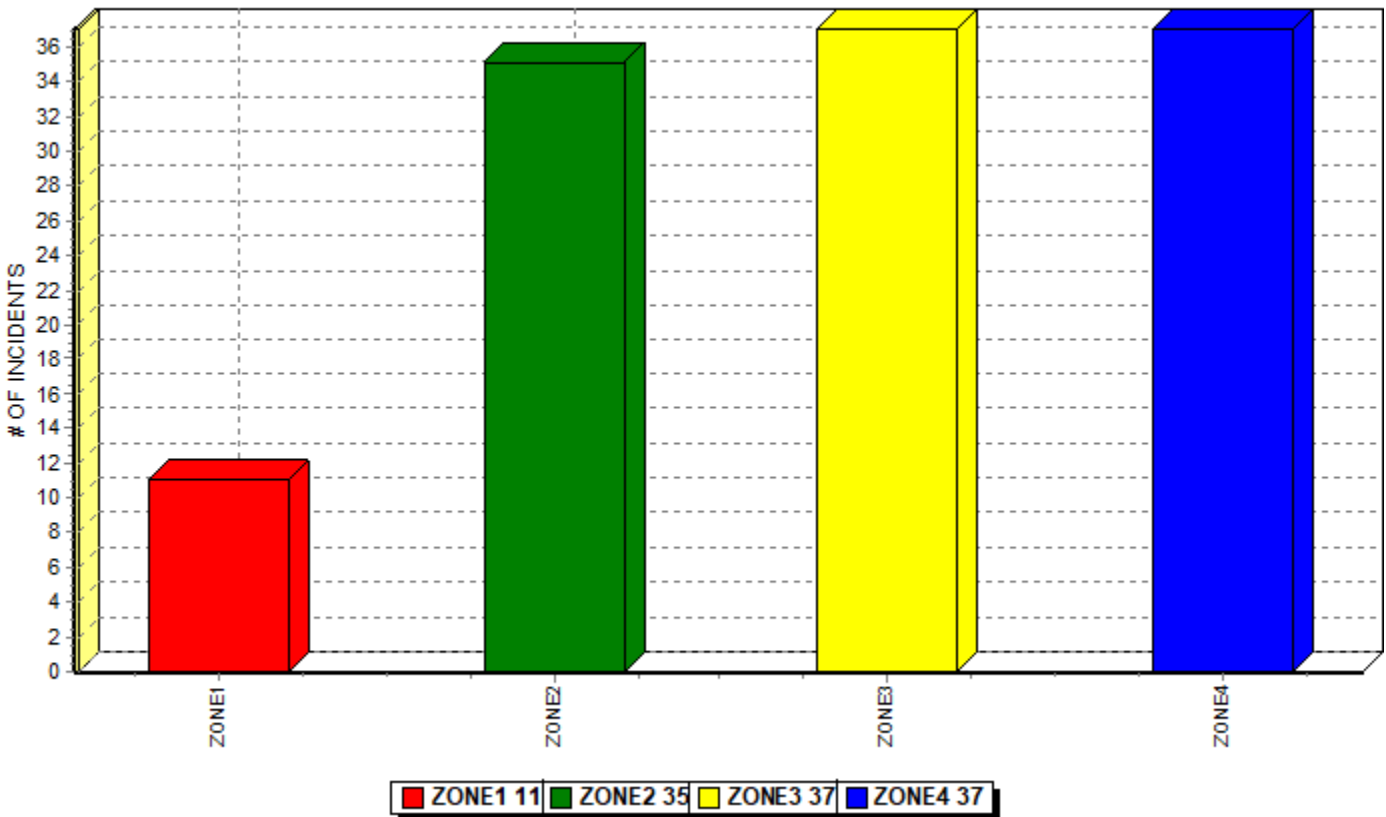

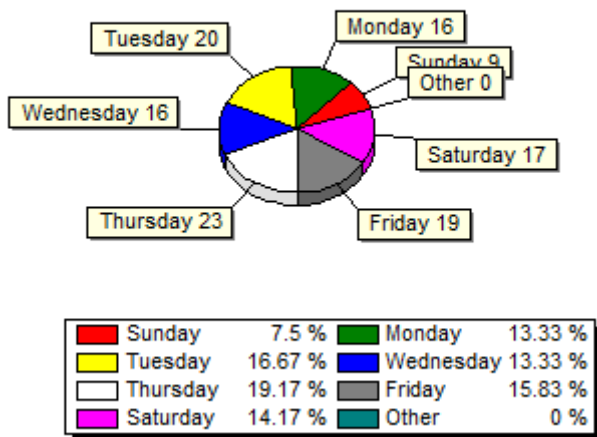

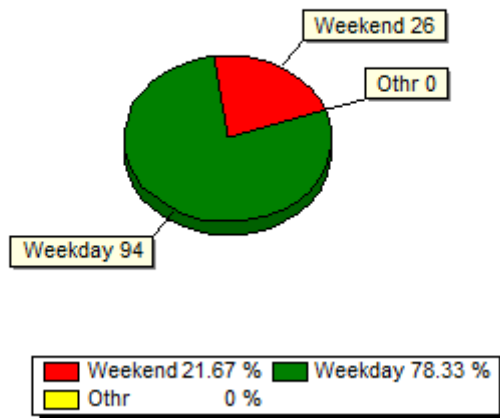
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)



By Day of Week

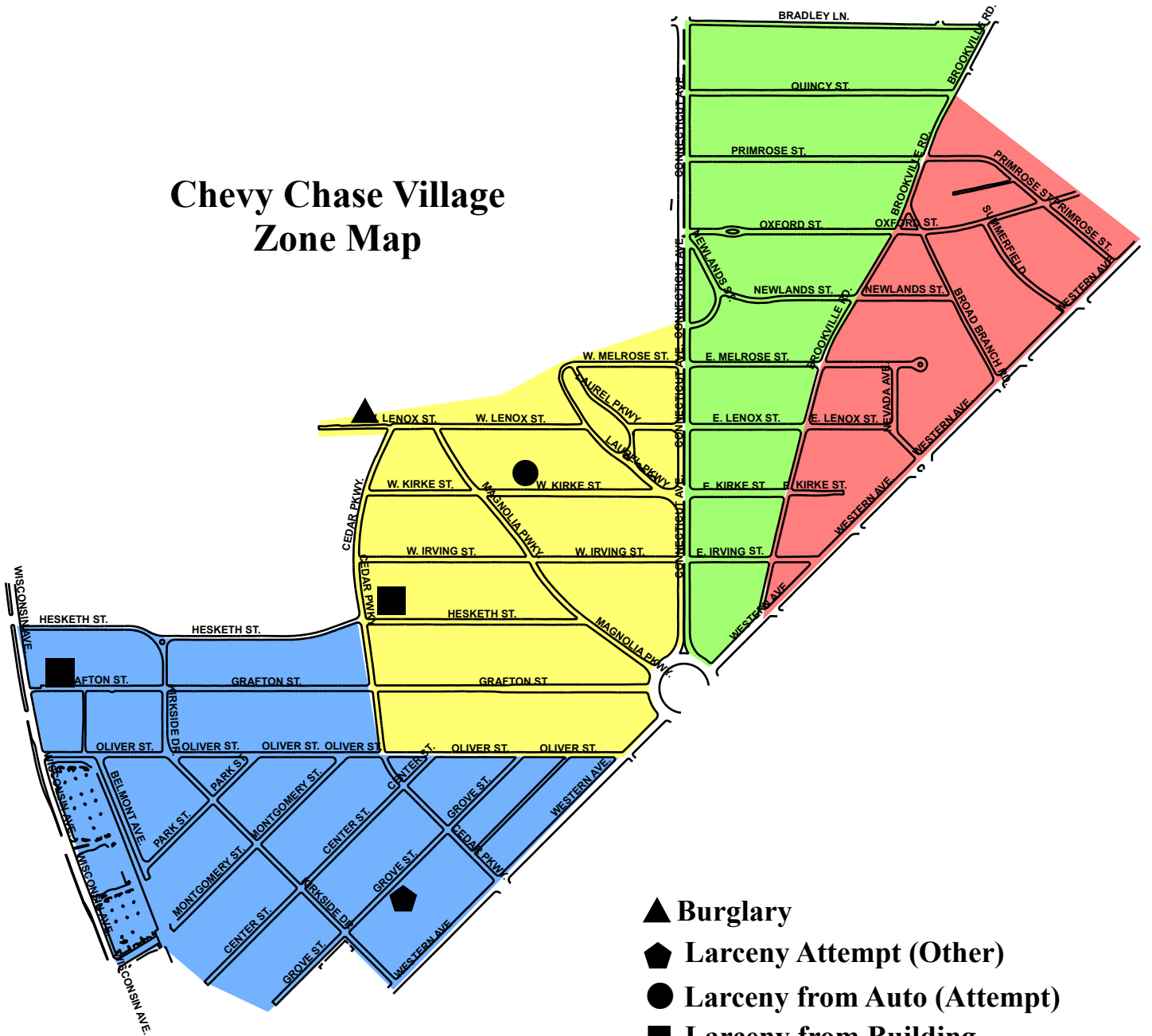


Weekday vs Weekend
