

## January 2020 CCVPD Highlights

### I. Crime/Operational

**A. Package theft—unit block of Primrose Street:** On New Year’s Day between 11:30 a.m. and 12:45 p.m., the residents saw a package on their front porch as they drove away from the house; it was gone when they returned. Contents valued at \$40.

**B. Daytime thefts from auto (2 unlocked; 2 windows broken):**

- **W. Kirke between Magnolia and Cedar:** On Wednesday, January 15, a contractor parked his unlocked work van at noon. When he returned to the van at 1:40 p.m., he discovered that tools valued at approximately \$1,000 had been taken.
- **Unit block of Grafton Street:** On Saturday, January 18, a worker parked his van leaving his smart phone in view on the dashboard. When he returned to the van 15 minutes later, he found the driver’s window smashed and his phone taken.
- **Unit block of Primrose Street:** On Wednesday, January 22 at about 2:30 p.m., a housekeeper saw two men pull up in a silver sedan. One got out and pulled on the door handle of her locked car, then he crossed the street and opened the unlocked door of a work van and stole the worker’s briefcase and the contents. The housekeeper delayed calling the police for 10 minutes.
- **6300 block of Broad Branch Road:** On Thursday, January 23 between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., unknown person(s) smashed the window of a car belonging to a housekeeper and stole a child’s lunch box and \$5 in cash.

**New dispatcher hired:** On February 3, Ms. Allison Shumake, 20, of Woodbine, Maryland, started her training with the Communications Center to fill the dispatcher vacancy (Ms. Racara Sawyer resigned in January). 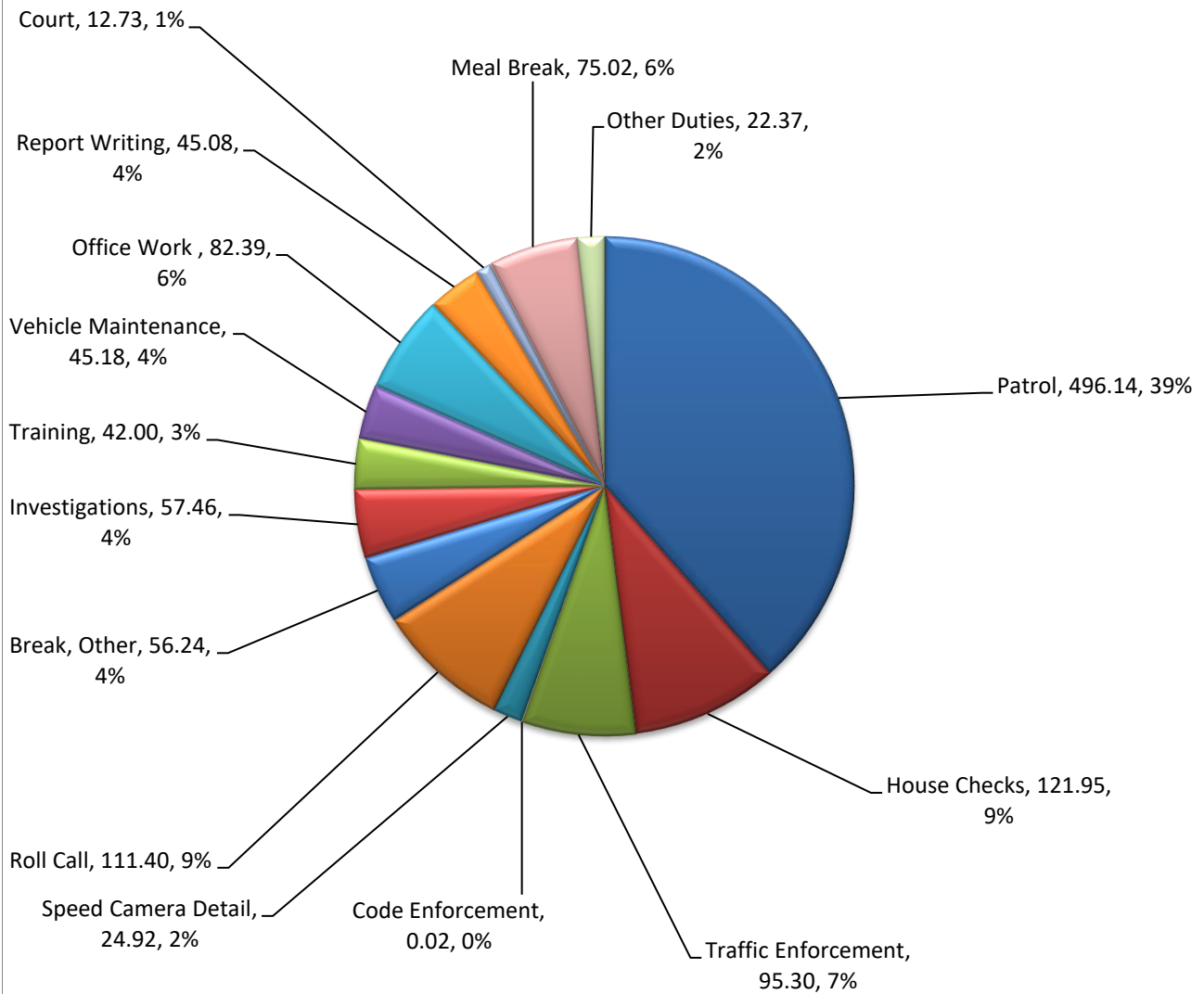

## Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for January 2020 within Chevy Chase Village

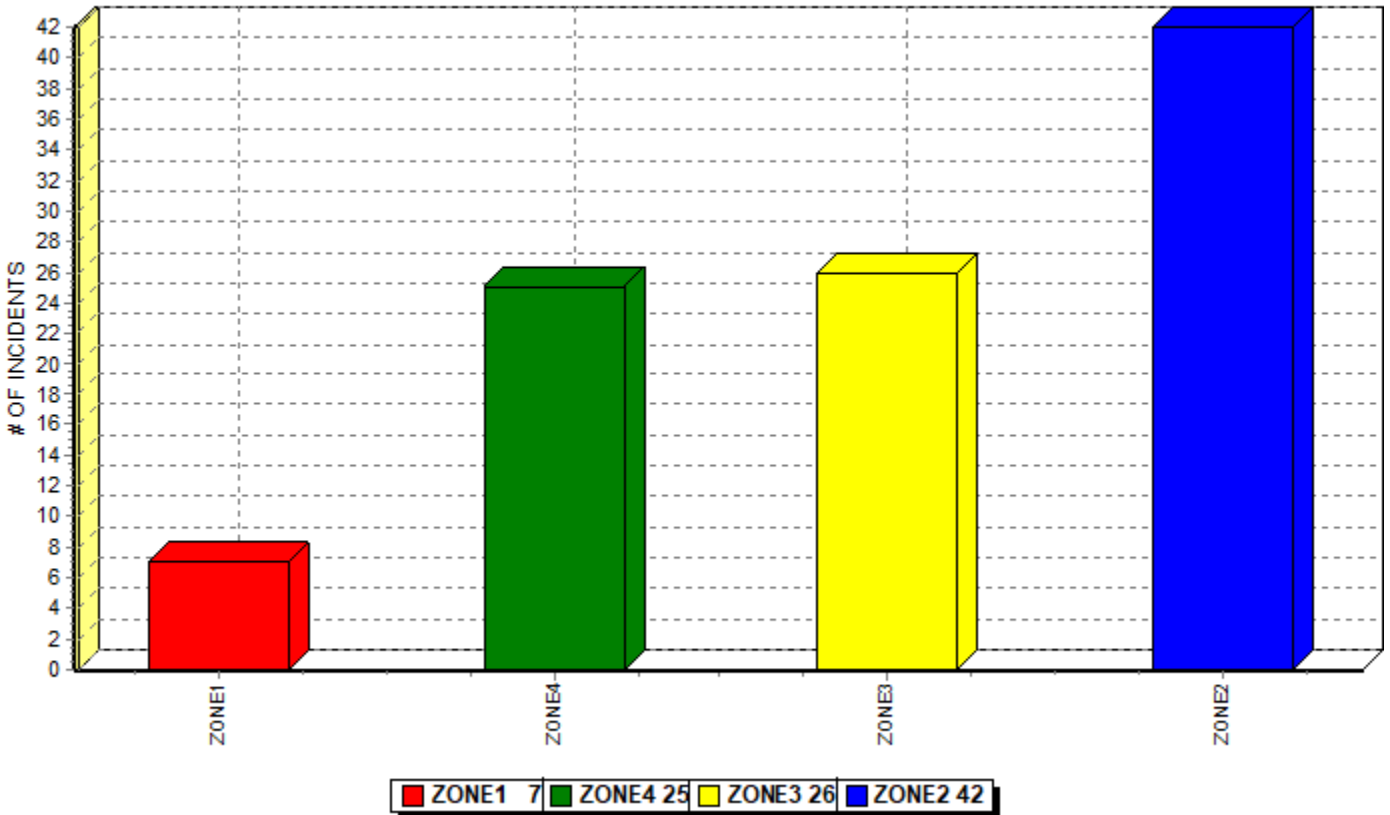

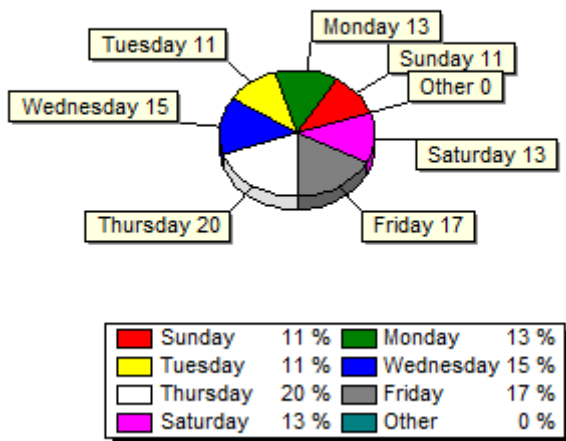

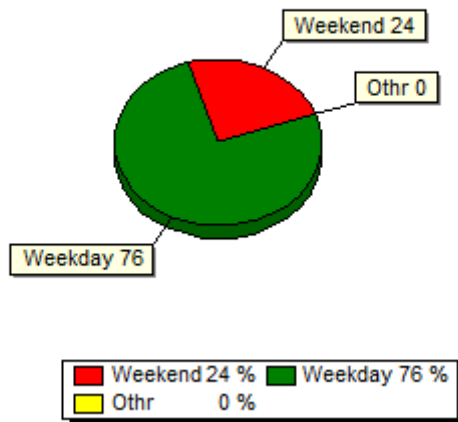
**Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)**



**By Day of Week**

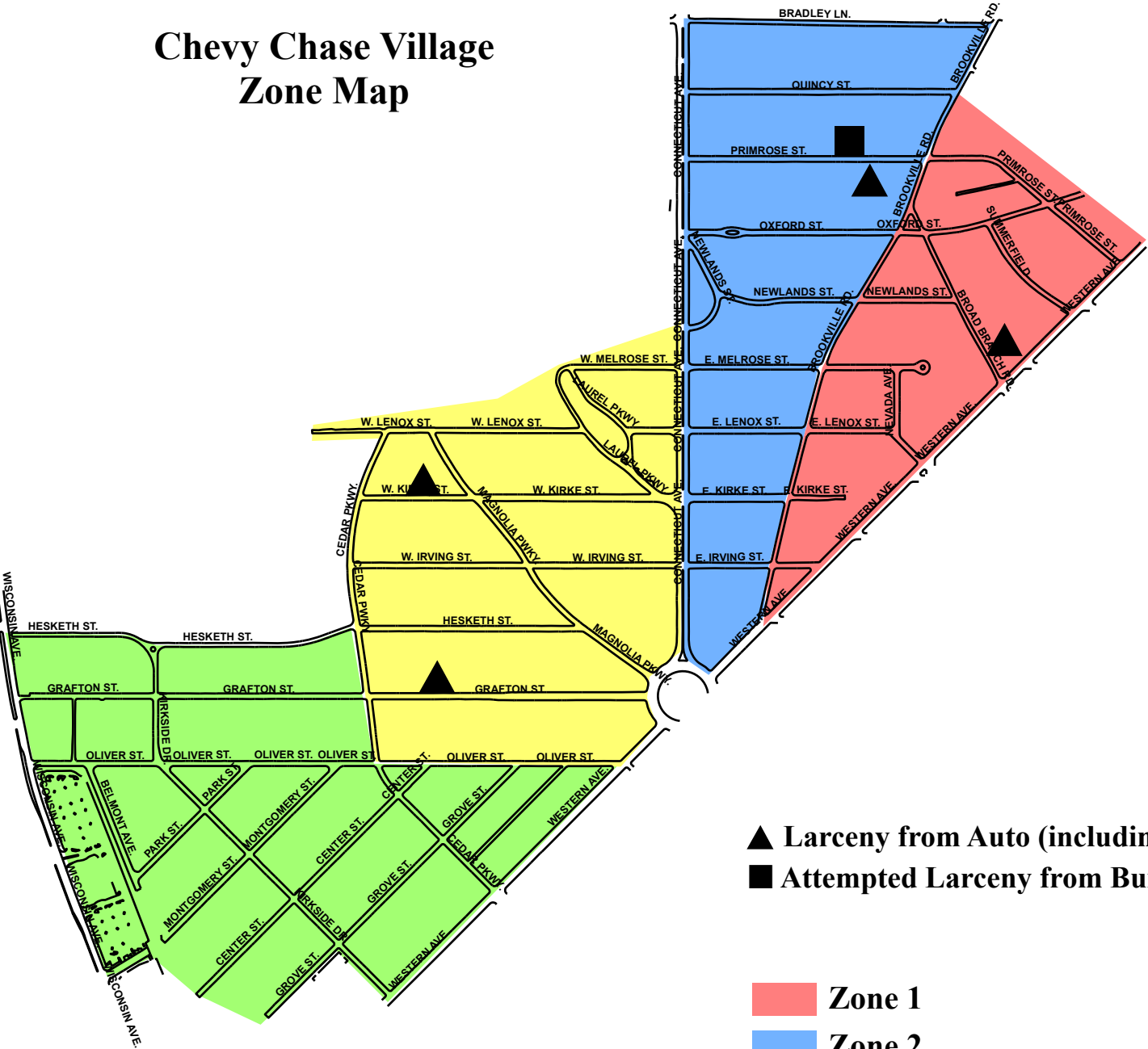


**Weekday vs Weekend**
