

## March 2020 CCVPD Highlights

### I. COVID-19 Pandemic operations

- We are engaged with federal, state and local officials via recurring conference calls, email and text updates, and other outreach as necessary.
- We have issued over a dozen operations orders to modify the way we work to keep our staff from becoming sick and to provide guidance as we implement the Governor’s Executive Orders. All of our officers and dispatchers have adjusted and no one has missed a shift; all personnel are currently healthy.
- Lt. Dasilva is overseeing the inventory, distribution and use of PPE; he continues to search for new sources to replenish our inventory; we are in good shape with most items for the time being.

### II. Nighttime thefts from auto dominated our reported incidents this month

- **March 4-5**—sunglasses taken from an unlocked car; unsuccessful attempt to enter a second car in the 6100 block of Nevada
- **March 6-7**—multiple unlocked cars entered (Montgomery, Hesketh, Cedar, Melrose, Kirkside) and one car stolen with a key (Oliver Street)
- **March 11-13**—unsuccessful attempt to steal radio from unlocked car on middle block of Hesketh
- **March 30**—two unlocked cars entered on Grafton; nothing taken from one, \$60 tool taken from the other

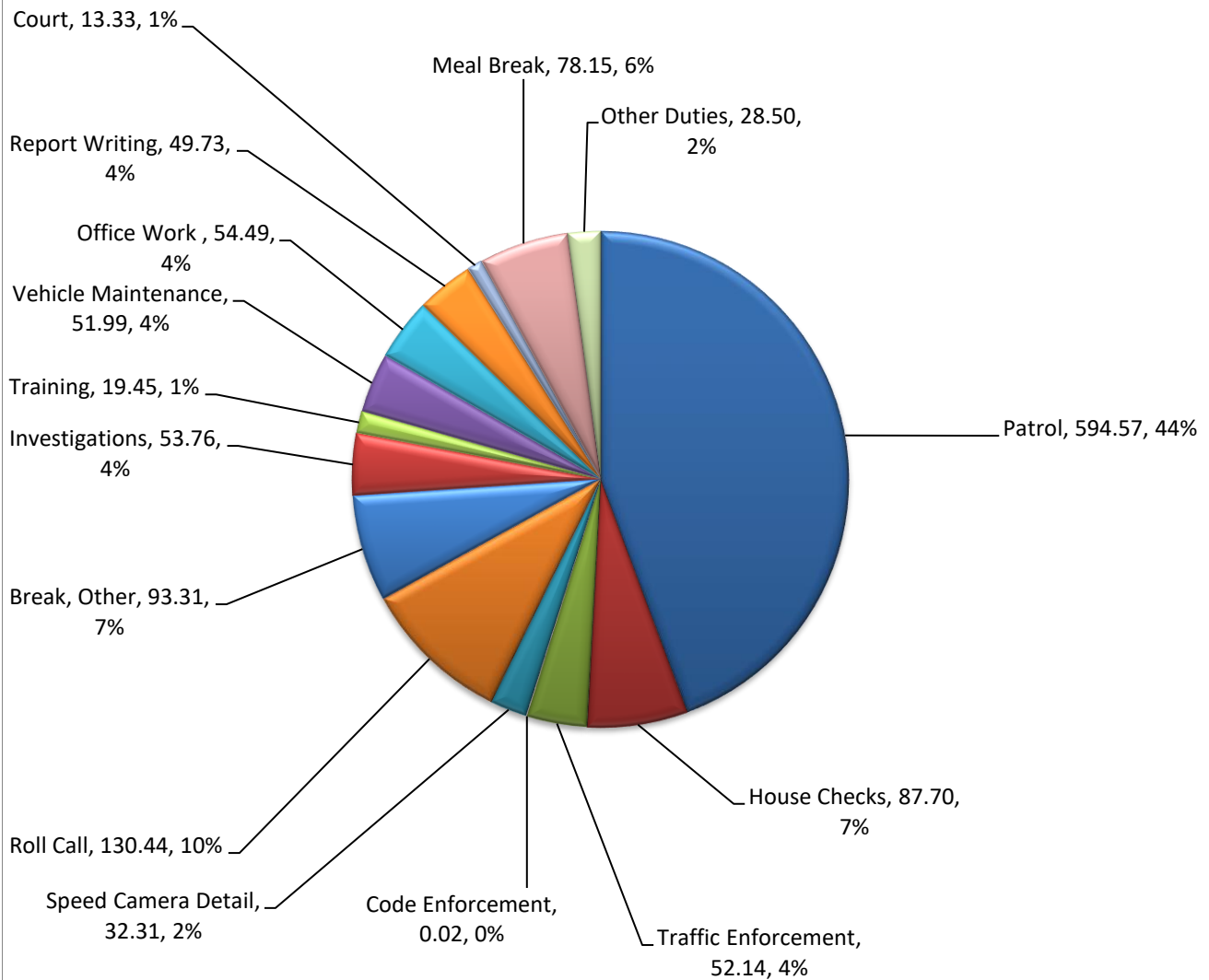
