

September 2022 CCVPD Highlights

Operational

- **Car stolen (key fob left inside) and recovered:** Overnight 9/16-9/17, unknown person(s) drove off in an SUV; the owner had left the key fob inside the car. GPS technology located the car in DC later that same day, and the car was recovered without any damage.
- **Windows broken on 3 housekeepers' cars:** On 9/22, thieves entered two cars owned by housekeepers—one on Center Street, the other on Hesketh Street—around 3pm by breaking a side window; purses were taken. On 9/27, thieves similarly broke into a third car owned by a housekeeper on E. Melrose Street. A neighbor's security camera captured the suspect vehicle: a forest green 4-door sedan.
- **Two catalytic converters removed from cars in 5400 block of Center:** In the early morning hours of 9/23, the catalytic converters were removed from two Toyota Prius automobiles. In one of the events, two suspects were captured on video as they got out of a white SUV and used cutting tools remove one of the catalytic converters. The theft took about one minute, and the loud noise from the tool apparently didn't disturb anyone.
- **3 unlocked cars entered:** Overnight 9/9-9/10, two residents in the 6300 block of Broad Branch Road reported that their unlocked cars were entered and rummaged through. A checkbook was taken from one car; a jacket was taken from another.

Administrative

- **Personnel changes in Communications:** On Friday, 9/23, we terminated a probationary Communications Clerk. We immediately reached out to a person who had previously interviewed with us, and effective October 10, Mr. Micah Stryker will join us to fill that vacancy. On Friday, October 7, 10-year veteran dispatcher John Beall resigned to take a similar position with the City of Rockville. We are actively recruiting to replace him.

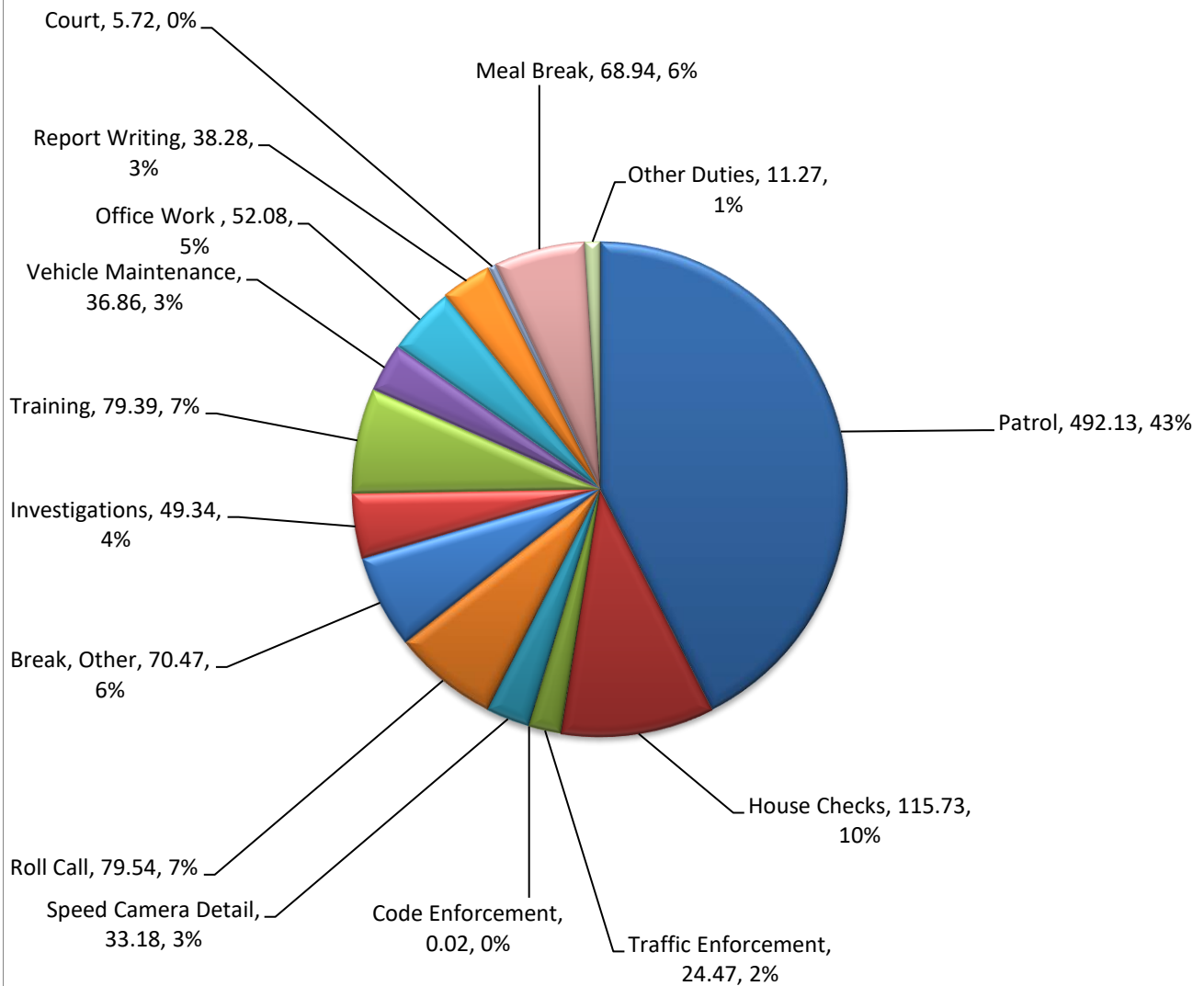

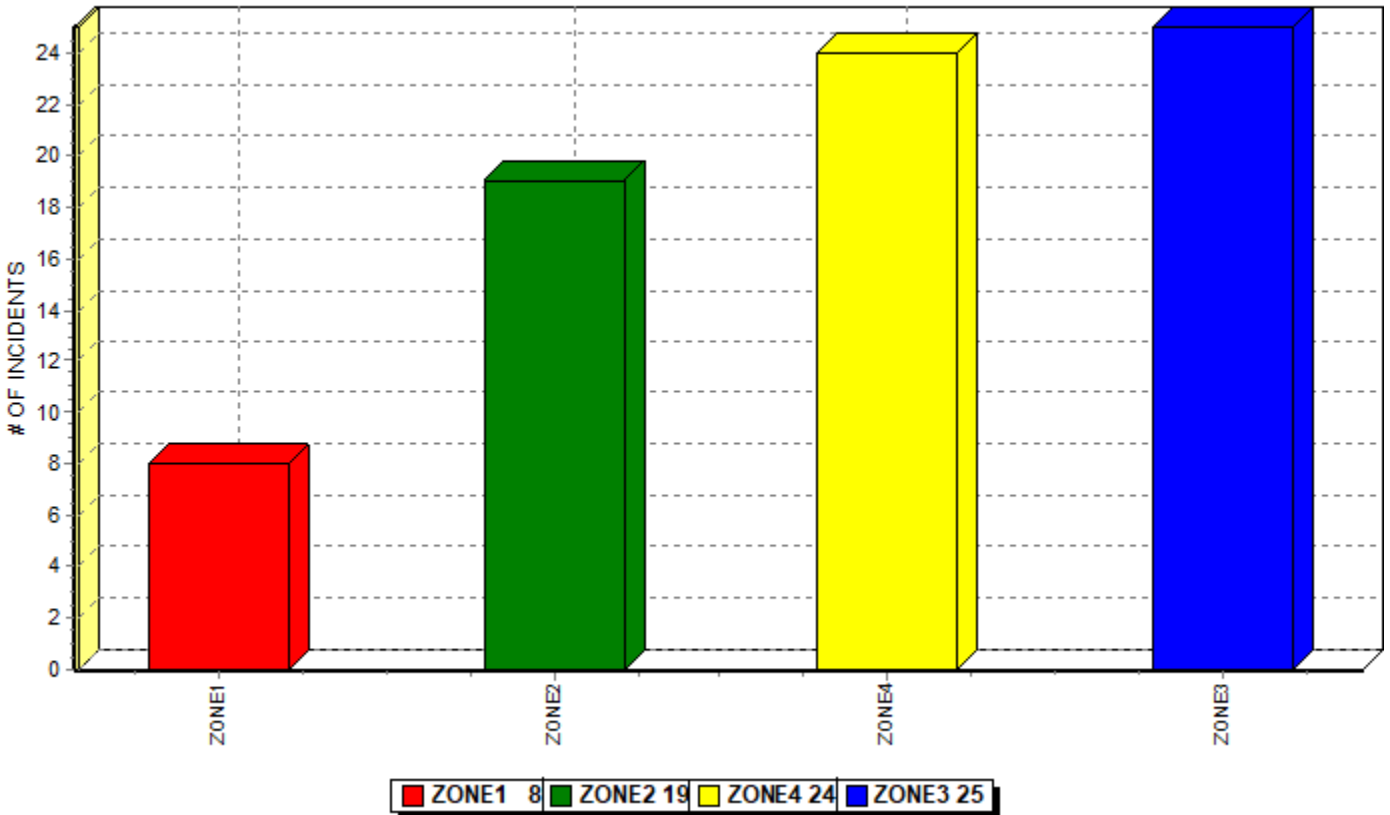

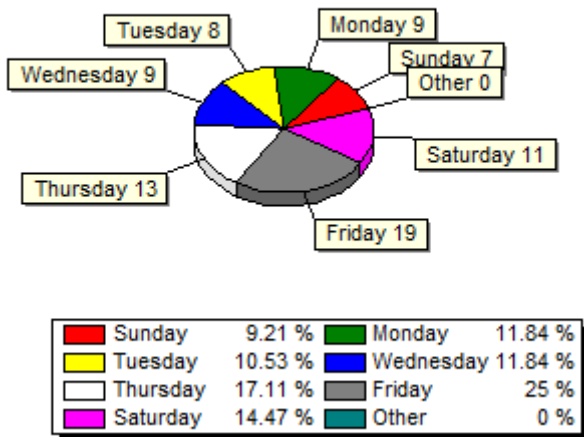

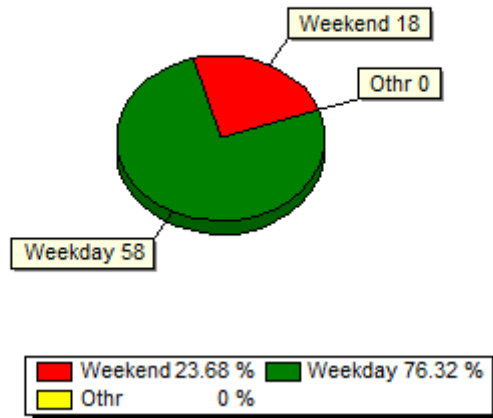
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
